CHANGING YOUR TOMORROW

RULE 1:

When we use an action word with the pronouns I or you in the Simple Present tense, the letter **-s is not added** to the action word.



I love reading books.



You clean your room every day.

RULE 2:

When we use an action word with **she, he or any singular naming word** in the Simple Present tense, we **add the letter -s** to the action word.



She plays basketball.



He gets up early in the morning.
