# **ADVERBS**





The dog barks loudly



Snails move slowly

Here, the words *loudly* and *slowly* tell us how the actions are done.

Loudly tells us how the dog barks.

*Slowly* tells us how snails *move*.

Such words are called adverbs.

Most adverbs end with ly.

Amit reads the poem loudly.



Raju speaks quickly.



The child sleeps quietly.
