




# What???



The question word, 'what' is used when asking for information about something.

### **EXAMPLE:**

- 1. What is your name?
- 2. What is a scrapbook?
- 3. What are you doing?
- 4. What is your favourite colour?
- 5. What do you eat for breakfast?

# Where???



The question word, 'where' is used when asking in or at what place or position.

### **EXAMPLE:**

- 1. Where do you live?
- 2. Where is my pencil box?
- 3. Where is the car parked?
- 4. Where is Konark temple located?
- 5. Where is your brother?

# When???



The question word, 'when' is used when asking about time.


### **EXAMPLE:**

- 1. When will the party start?
- 2. When did you finish your homework?
- 3. When did he leave?
- 4. When did Ravi come?
- 5. When is your lunch break?
