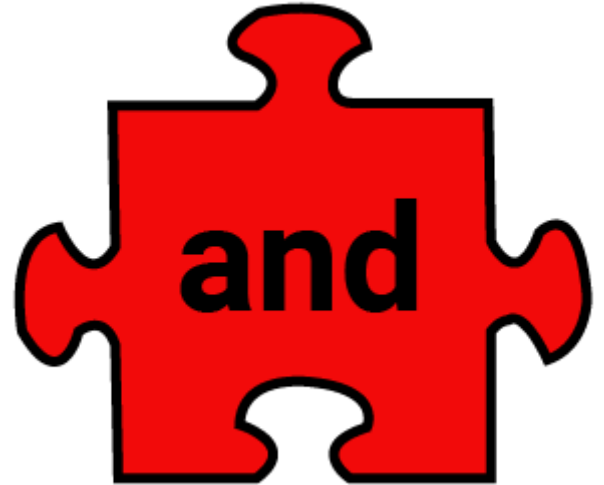

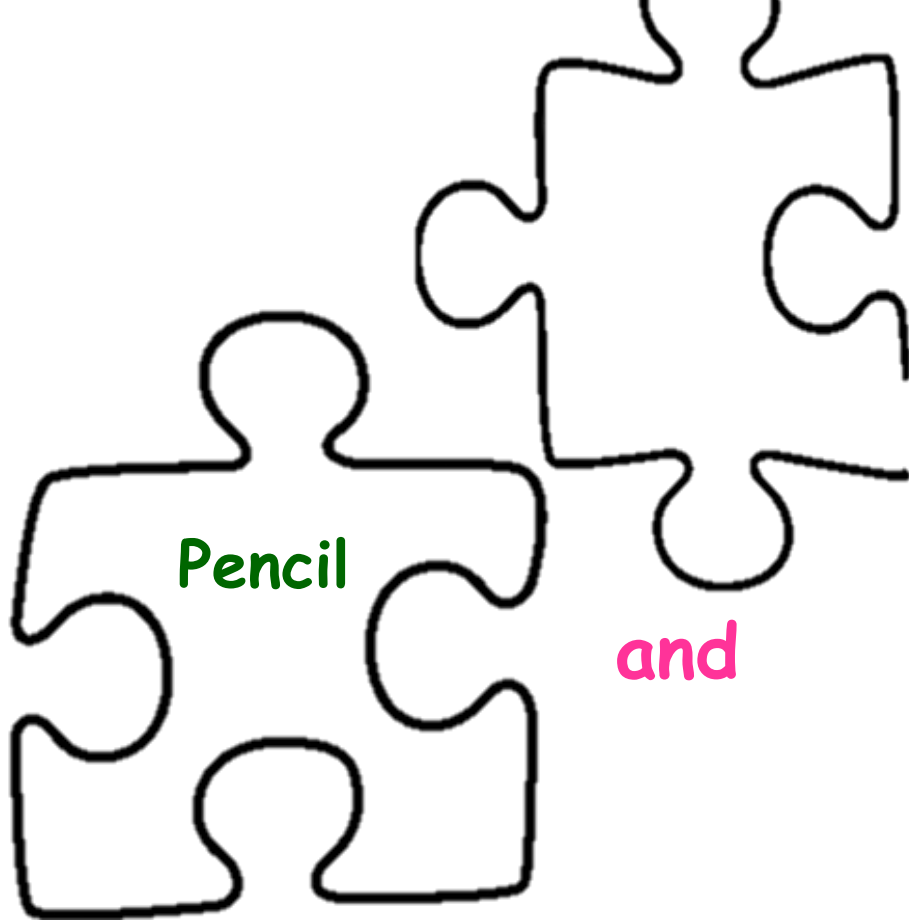
CHAPTER- 17

JOINING WORD: *AND*

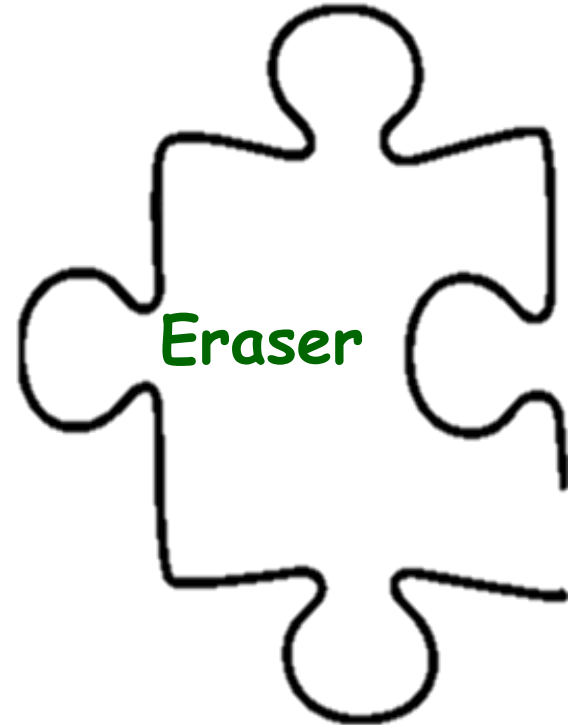
'*And*' is used to join nouns, pronouns and sentences.

We use *and* to say something more.

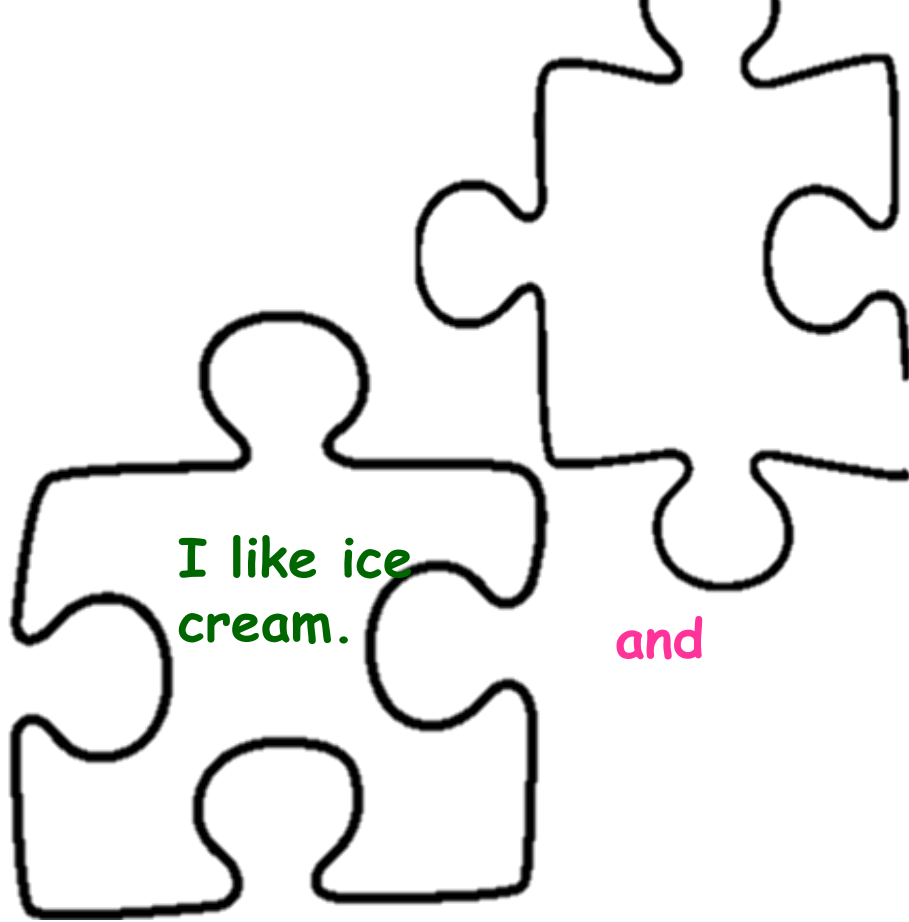

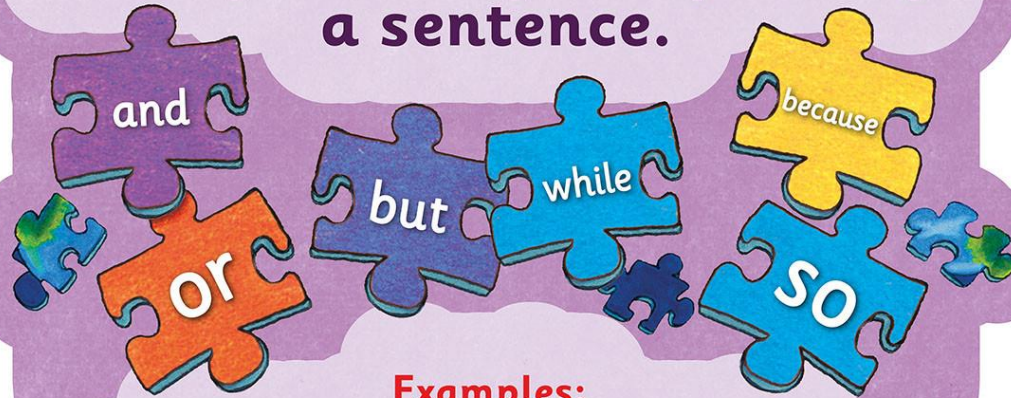

Conjunctions

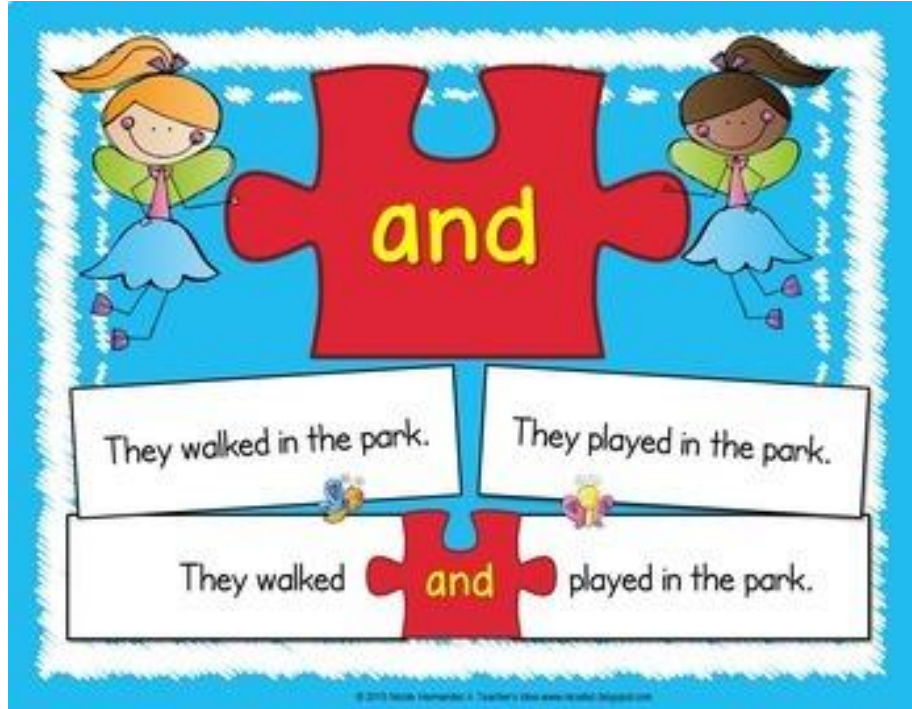
A conjunction joins parts of a sentence.



Examples:

I ate a sandwich **and** I drank some juice.

We can go to the park **or** we can go to the zoo.

Hamid is a swimmer.

and



Hamid is a dancer.

Hamid is a swimmer and a dancer.



Honey is sweet.

and

Honey is tasty.

Honey is sweet and tasty.



Gia is kind. Gia is caring.

Gia is kind and caring.
