Rimi likes to eat biscuits and drink grape juice.

Examples:-.

I will read the question. I will write the answer.
 We can join these two sentences with before.
 I will read the question before I write the answer.

Before is a joining word.

I eat my breakfast. I brush my teeth.
 We can join these two sentences with after.
 I eat my breakfast after I brush my teeth.

After is a joining word.
