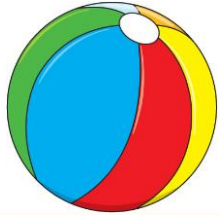

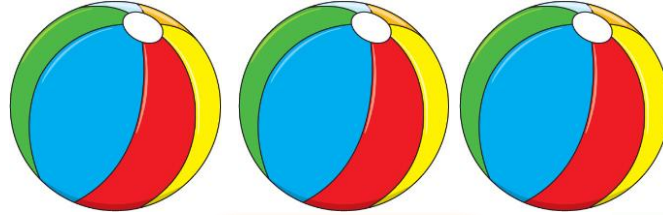

# CH - 4 Singular and Plural Nouns: Naming Words

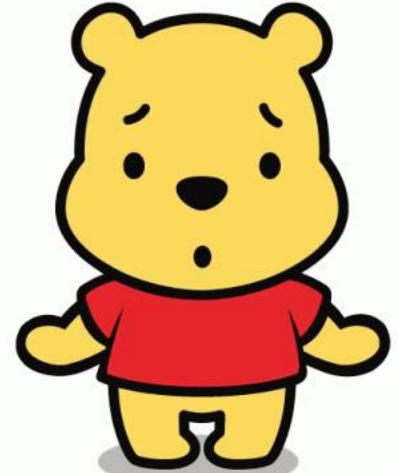
When we talk about more than one person, thing, place or animal we generally add 's' to the words and it becomes a Plural Noun.
