The turtle
walked slowly.



He went to the
beach today.



My dog ran
over there.



ADVERBS

Adverbs usually describe verbs.

Adverbs tell:

HOW (manner)

WHEN (time)

WHERE (place)



adverbs of manner

Adverbs of manner



He walks **quickly**



My sister speaks **loudly**.



My grandmother is old .she walks **slowly**



Shshsh, you must **spea** **quietly**.

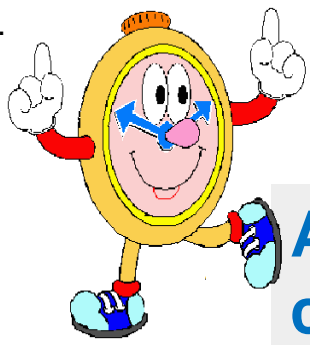


She paints **beautifully**.



She dances **gracefully**.





Adverbs of Time

Adverbs that tell us **when** an action happens are called adverbs of time.

Example-

1. Let us go to the park **today**.
2. We must wake up **now**.
3. I met her **yesterday**.
4. I will eat the litchis **later**.
5. He **never** goes out with his friends.



Adverbs of Place

Adverbs that tell us where an action happens are called adverbs of place.

Example-

ADVERB OF PLACE

HE WAS SEEN **NOWHERE**.
PLEASE COME **IN**.
HE LIVES **HERE**.



Words that tell us where something happened are called ***adverbs of place***. They do not end with ***ly***.

Examples:



Peter is **here**.



The group is singing **outside**.

Few more examples:
