☐ Prepositions are words that show position and time in a sentence. ☐ In and on are prepositions of place and time. ☐ In is also used to talk about a period of time such as days, years, months and seasons. ☐ On is also used to talk about a day or date on which a particular event happens. ☐ At is used to talk about specific time or place. ☐ Under is used when someone or something is below something else. • Over is used when someone or something is above something else. ■ Below is used when something is kept/placed at a position lower than something else.

Inside and outside:



inside is used to say about something is within something else.

Outside is used to say about something is out of something else. It is opposite of inside.

Example -




Outside


