START WITH THESE...

Who?

What?

Where?

When?

Why?

Questions

A question asks you something. It ends with a question mark.

when?

what?

who?

how?

why?

where?



What are you drawing?

Statements

A statement tells you about something. It ends with a period.



We are drawing a sun.

What?

The question word, 'what' is used when asking for information about something.

EXAMPLE:

1. What is your name?
2. What is a scrapbook?
3. What are you doing?
4. What is your favourite colour?
5. What do you eat for breakfast?

Where?

The question word, 'where' is used when asking in or at what place or position.

EXAMPLE:

1. Where do you live?
2. Where is my pencil box?
3. Where is the car parked?
4. Where is Konark temple located?
5. Where is your brother?

When?

The question word, 'when' is used when asking about time.

EXAMPLE:

1. When will the party start?
2. When did you finish your homework?
3. When did he leave?
4. When did Ravi come?
5. When is your lunch break?

Which?

The question word, 'which' is used when asking about choice or something in particular.

EXAMPLE:

1. Which is your pen, the black one or the red one?
2. Which fruit do you like most?
3. Which dress did he wear on his birthday?
4. Which book does he want?
5. Which girl are you talking about?

Why?

The question word, 'why' is used when asking about reason.

EXAMPLE:

1. Why did you go there?
2. Why are you late?
3. Why is she crying?
4. Why did Ravi come?
5. Why were they playing in the rain?

Let's Summarize

Question about	Question word	Example
Place	Where	Where are you going? Answer: I am going to the playground with my friends.
Time	when	When do you go to school? Answer: I go to school at 8 o'clock.
Reason	why	Why are you late? Answer: I am late because there was a traffic jam.
Thing	what	What do you have in your hand? Answer: I have a pencil box in my hand.
Choice or something in particular	which	Which grade are you in? Answer: I am in second grade.
