Nouns are the naming words, name of persons, places, animals and things.

Examples:



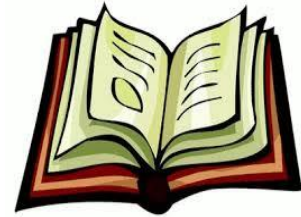
Mother

What are common & proper nouns?



A **common noun** is any **general noun** that represents a **person, place, thing** or **idea**.

A **proper noun** gives a **NAME** to a **common noun**.

Now, look at this table. These are a few examples of common and proper nouns.

Common Nouns	Proper Nouns
people	Kiran, Rani, Sneha, Noorie, Lalita, Arav, Eshan, Rehman, Babita, Nilima, Anu
cities	Delhi, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Kolkata
countries	India, England, Japan, China, Nepal, Bangladesh
stories	The Ugly Duckling, Three Little Pigs, The Princess and the Frog
movies	Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, Frozen, How to Train Your Dragon

The first letter of a proper noun is always a capital letter.

Let's Read



Mili is a little **girl**.



Ramesh loves watching **movies**.

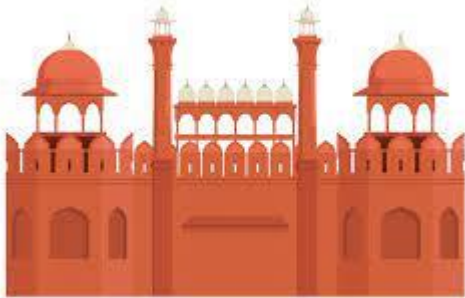


Timmy has a pet **rabbit** named **Candy**.

Mili, **Ramesh**, **Timmy** and **Candy** are proper nouns. Whereas, **girl**, **movies**, **rabbit** are common nouns.



Ronnie loves to read. So, his sister gifted him a book.

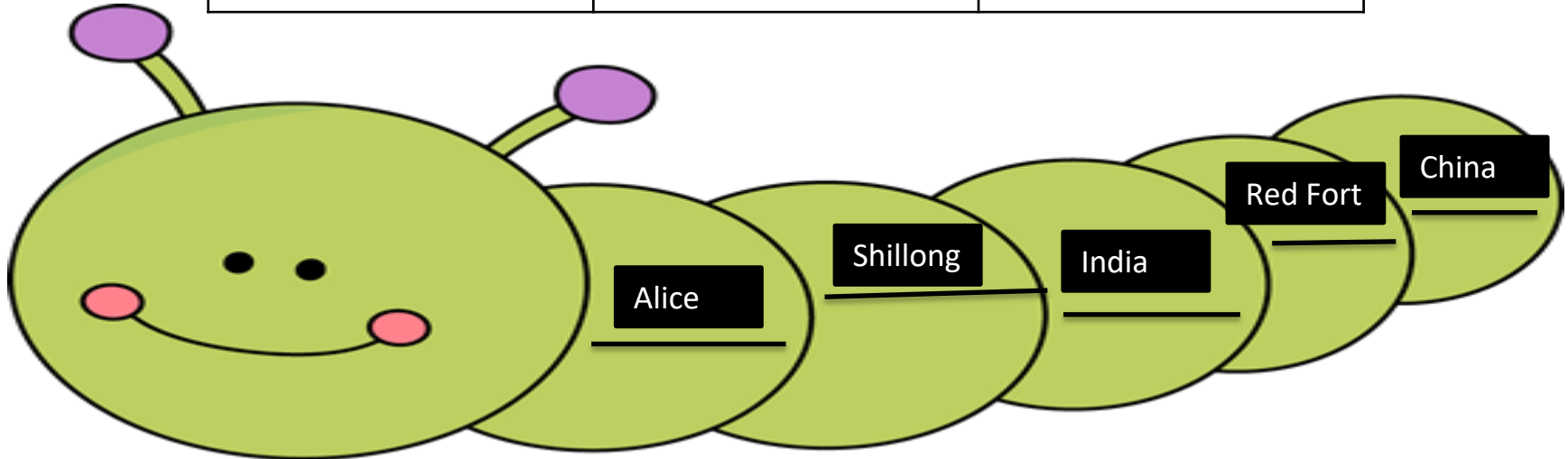


She lives near the Red Fort.

Ronnie and Red Fort are proper nouns. Whereas, sister and book are common nouns.
