# NOUNS ARE DIVIDED INTO DIFFERENT TYPES OF GENDER.

**MASCULINE:** The words for men, boys, and male animals.



**FEMININE:** The words for women, girls, and female animals.



**COMMON GENDER:** The words that can be used for both man and woman/ boy and girl



**NEUTER GENDER:** The words that are not a boy or girl/ man or woman. These are things.
