Pronoun

STUDY NOTES

At a glance

A pronoun is a word that can be used in the place of a naming word (noun) in a sentence.

- The pronouns 'I', 'he', 'she', 'you', and 'it' are used for singular nouns.
- 'It' is used for single thing or animal.
- 'They', 'we', 'us', 'them', 'you' pronouns are used for plural nouns.
- 'Me' is used when the speaker talks about herself or himself.
- 'You' is used when the speaker talks about the listener. It may be one or more person.
- We use 'him' to talk about a boy or a man while 'her' to talk about a girl or a woman.
- 'Us' and 'them' are used in place of more than one person.

Example - Rajesh teases me all the time.

I don't like him.

Ramesh likes apple he eats them daily.

Mina is going with her mother.

They play with us.

She gave it to me.
