


A pronoun is a word that replaces the name of a person or object (nouns).







## **PRONOUNS**


Some pronouns take the place of nouns that come after a verb.







## We use some pronouns after the verb in the following forms:





#### **HER**



I love **my sister** very much.

I love <u>her</u> very much.



#### HIM



My mom loves my brother.

My mom loves him.





Rohan has a ball. He likes the ball very much.

He likes it very much.



#### **THEM**



Sheena likes **her friends**.

Sheena likes them.



#### US



We were shouting.
The teacher told <u>us</u> to keep quiet.


