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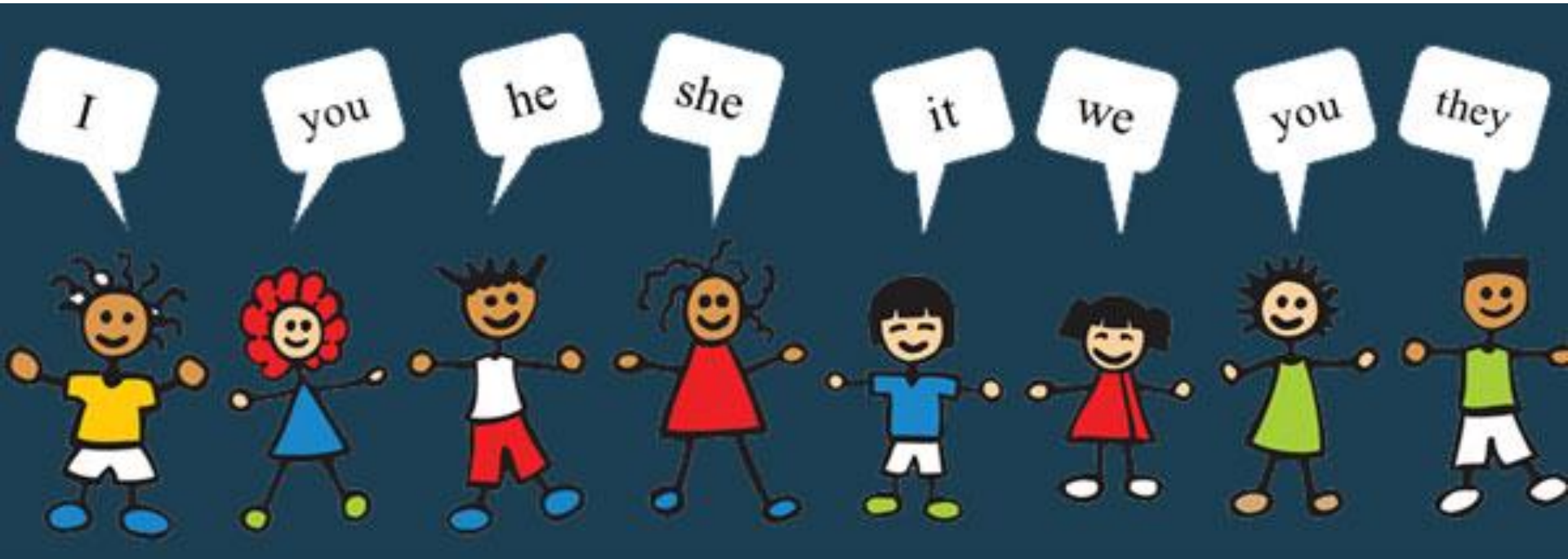

**Pronouns**

A pronoun is a word that replaces the name of a person or object (nouns).



# REMEMBER

- We use pronouns to avoid repetition of the same nouns.
- ‘He’, ‘she’ , ‘it’ are used for singular nouns.
- ‘It’ is used for single things or animals.
- ‘They’ and ‘we’ are used for plural nouns.
- ‘I’ and ‘you’ are also pronouns.

Some pronouns take the place of nouns that come after a verb.



We use some pronouns after the verb in the following forms.

I	→	me
You	→	you
He	→	him
She	→	her
It	→	it
They	→	them
