





Chapter- 7

This, That, These, Those

STUDY NOTES

At a glance

- **This, that, these, those** are used to talk about particular people or things.
- **This** and **that** are used for one person or thing. **These** and **those** are used for more than one person or thing.
- **This** and **these** are used to refer people or things near us.
- **That** and **those** are used to refer to people or things far from us.

<p>This Singular</p>  <p>For example: I like <u>this</u> apple.</p>	<p>That Singular</p>  <p>For example: I like <u>that</u> apple.</p>
<p>These Plural</p>  <p>For example: I like <u>these</u> apple.</p>	<p>Those Plural</p>  <p>For example: I like <u>those</u> apple.</p>
