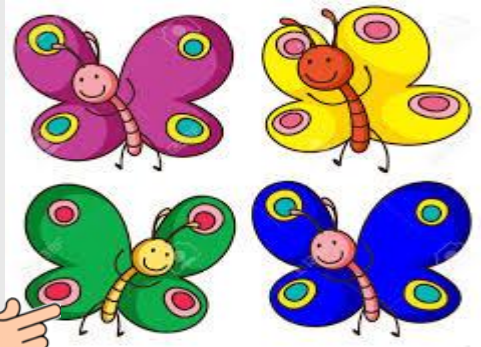

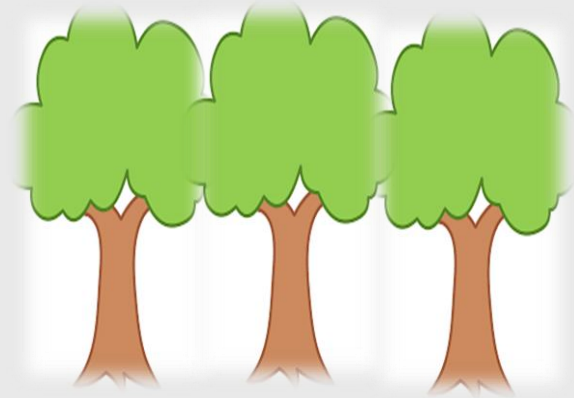

'Those' is used for only plural nouns far from us.

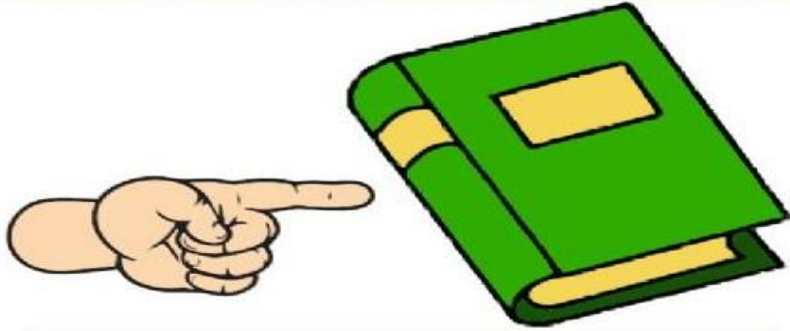
