Look at the words in **red**. They are both used to talk about something that is going to happen.

We use **will** and **going to** when:

- We talk about things that are going to happen

For Example:

She is **going to** sing for us.

We **will** come back from the school in the afternoon.

- We talk about plans

For Example:

Rohan **will** visit his cousin's house on the weekend.

I am **going to** colour the blue bird.

I am going to buy a new pencil box.

Rohan is going to have pasta for dinner.

He is going to paint a picture now.

They are going to plant a tree.

Will

Bill will join swimming classes this summer.

I will get a glass of water for you.

She will help me with my homework.

My mother will take us on a vacation next week.
