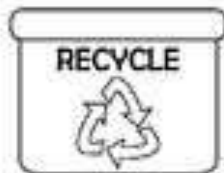
Earth Day, Earth Day,

- We live on the Earth.
- The Earth is shaped like an orange-round and slightly flat at the top and at the bottom.
- We share the Earth with plants and other animals.
- The Earth is called a blue planet because more than 71% of the earth is covered with water.
- A globe is a model of Earth.
- The Earth is covered with land, water and air.



LAND:

- There are different kinds of lands.
- A large area of flat land is called a plain.
- Crops grow well on the plains.



Plain

MOUNTAIN:

- Very high land is called a hill or a mountain.
- Some crops like tea and coffee grow well in hilly areas.



Mountain

DESERT:

- A large area of land that has very little water and where very few plants grow is called a desert.
- Many deserts are covered with sand.



Desert

WATER:

- A large part of the Earth is covered with water.
- There is water in the oceans, rivers, lakes and ponds.
- We need water to drink, cook our food, wash our clothes and keep ourselves clean.



- We must use water carefully and should not throw garbage and other wastes into the rivers and seas.
- It makes the water dirty.
