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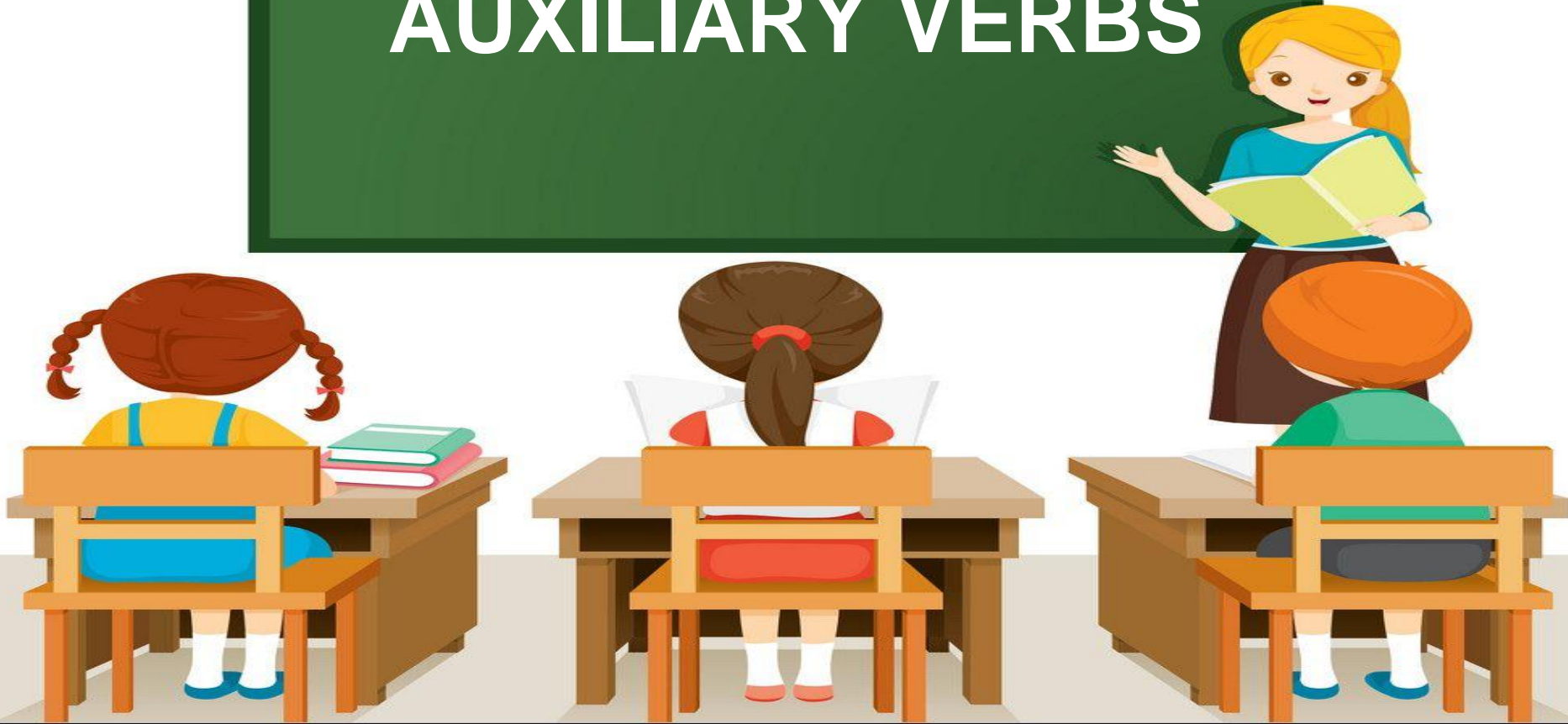

# AUXILIARY VERBS






An auxiliary verb is often paired with the main verb to form the tense.

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
<p>be</p> 	<p>Singular – <b>am, is</b></p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>I <b>am</b> watching a movie.</p> <p>He <b>is</b> watching a movie.</p>	<p>Singular – <b>was</b></p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>I <b>was</b> watching a movie.</p> <p>He <b>was</b> watching a movie.</p>
<p>be</p> 	<p>Plural – <b>are</b></p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>We <b>are</b> watching a movie.</p> <p>They <b>are</b> watching a movie.</p>	<p>Plural – <b>were</b></p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>We <b>were</b> watching a movie.</p> <p>They <b>were</b> watching a movie.</p>

The auxiliary verb **do** helps to ask question.

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
<p>do</p> 	<p><b>Singular – does</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> He <b>does</b> not <b>eat</b> pizza. She <b>does</b> not <b>eat</b> pizza.</p>	<p><b>Singular &amp; Plural – did</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> <b>Did</b> you <b>eat</b> pizza? <b>Did</b> they <b>eat</b> pizza?</p>
<p>do</p> 	<p><b>Personal &amp; Plural – do</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> I <b>do</b> not <b>eat</b> pizza. You <b>do</b> not <b>eat</b> pizza. They <b>do</b> not <b>eat</b> pizza.</p>	

The auxiliary verb **have** is used to indicate that an action is complete.

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
<p>have</p> 	<p><b>Singular – has</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> Sriya <b>has</b> completed all the work. Raj <b>has</b> completed all the work.</p>	<p><b>Singular &amp; Plural – had</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> She <b>had</b> completed all work. You <b>had</b> completed all the work. They <b>had</b> completed all the work.</p> 
<p>have</p> 	<p><b>Personal &amp; Plural – have</b></p> <p><b>Examples :</b> I <b>have</b> completed all the work. You <b>have</b> completed all the work. They <b>have</b> completed all the work.</p>
