

An auxiliary verb is often paired with the main verb to form the tense.

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
be	Singular – am, is	Singular – was
	Examples: I am watching a movie.	Examples: I was watching a movie.
	He is watching a movie.	He was watching a movie.
be	Plural – are	Plural – were
	Examples: We are watching a movie. They are watching a movie.	Examples: We were watching a movie. They were watching a movie.

The auxiliary verb do helps to ask question.



AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
do	Singular – does	Singular & Plural – did
	Examples: He does not eat pizza. She does not eat pizza.	Examples: Did you eat pizza?
do	Personal & Plural – do	Did they eat pizza?
	Examples: I do not eat pizza. You do not eat pizza. They do not eat pizza.	

The auxiliary verb have is used to indicate that an action is complete.



AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
have	Singular – has	Singular & Plural – had
	Examples: Sriya has completed all the work. Raj has completed all the work.	Examples: She had completed all work. You had completed all the work.
have	Personal & Plural – have	They had completed all the work.
