














AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE		
be	Singular – am, is	Singular – was		
	Examples: I am watching a movie.	Examples: I was watching a movie.		
	He is watching a movie.	He was watching a movie.		
be	Plural – are	Plural – were		
	Examples: We are watching a movie. They are watching a movie.	Examples: We were watching a movie. They were watching a		



AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
do	Singular – does Examples: He does not eat pizza. She does not eat pizza.	Singular & Plural – did Examples: Did you eat pizza? Did they eat pizza?
do	Personal & Plural – do Examples: I do not eat pizza. You do not eat pizza. They do not eat pizza.	Did tiley eat pizza:
