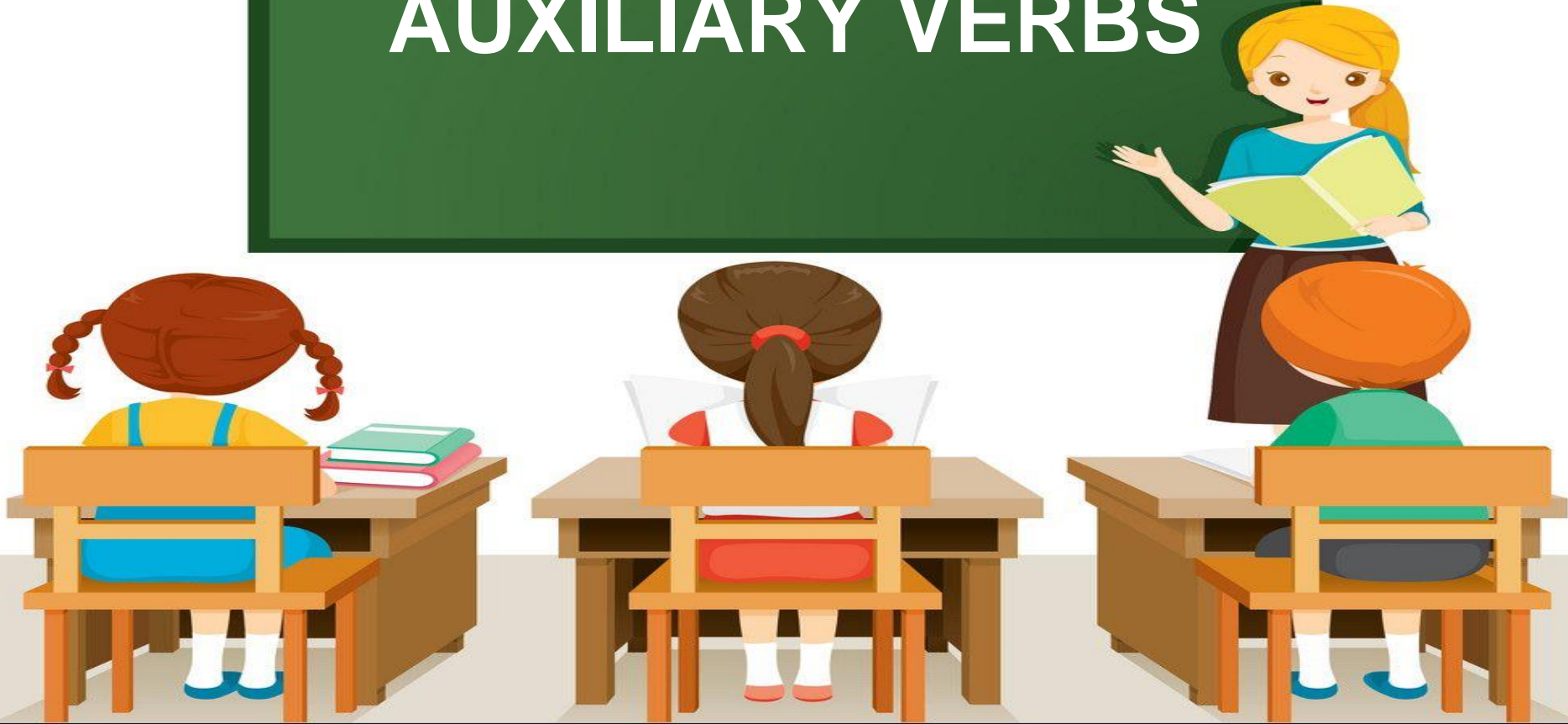

AUXILIARY VERBS



Read these sentences :





- The sun **is shining** and the birds **are singing**.
- The other animals **are relaxing** in the shade of the trees.
- The mother **is looking** for her baby.
- We **have read** all about the birds and animals.




The words in **red** in the sentences - **is, are** and **have** – are called **auxiliary verbs**.

Auxiliary verbs are also called **helping verbs**.



An auxiliary verb is often paired with the main verb to form the tense.

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
<p>be</p> 	<p>Singular – am, is</p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>I am watching a movie.</p> <p>He is watching a movie.</p>	<p>Singular – was</p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>I was watching a movie.</p> <p>He was watching a movie.</p>
<p>be</p> 	<p>Plural – are</p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>We are watching a movie.</p> <p>They are watching a movie.</p>	<p>Plural – were</p> <p>Examples :</p> <p>We were watching a movie.</p> <p>They were watching a movie.</p>

AUXILIARY VERB	PRESENT TENSE	PAST TENSE
<p>do</p> 	<p>Singular – does</p> <p>Examples : He does not eat pizza. She does not eat pizza.</p>	<p>Singular & Plural – did</p> <p>Examples : Did you eat pizza? Did they eat pizza?</p>
<p>do</p> 	<p>Personal & Plural – do</p> <p>Examples : I do not eat pizza. You do not eat pizza. They do not eat pizza.</p>
