

Question Words





Question Words

Where

QUESTION ABOUT Person



EXAMPLE

Q- **Who** hid my pen?
A- **Tina** hid your pen.



Q- **Who** opened the door?
A- **Arnab** opened the door.

QUESTION ABOUT Place



EXAMPLE

Q- **Where** are you going?
A- I am going to the **market**.



Q- **Where** do you want to go in the vacation?
A- In the vacation we want to go to **Shimla**.

When



Why

QUESTION ABOUT Time



Q- **When** do you want to start the work?
A-I want to start doing my work at **ten** in the morning.

Q- **When** does the next bus arrive?
A- The next bus will arrive at **6 o'clock**.

QUESTION ABOUT Reason



Q- **Why** are you crying?
A- I am crying **because I am upset**.



Q- **Why** are you late?
A- I am late **because of the traffic**.

What



Which

QUESTION ABOUT Thing



EXAMPLE

Q- **What** do you have in your hand ?
A- I have a **ball** in my hand.



Q- **What** you had for breakfast?
A- We had idlis for breakfast .

QUESTION ABOUT Choice or something in particular



EXAMPLE

Q- **Which** museum did you visit?
A- I visited **Victoria Memorial**



Q- **Which** pastry would you want to have?
A- I would like to have vanilla .

How (manner)



- ❖ How is used in what way the action was performed.
- ❖ They are also used to ask about the condition, amount or quality of something.

EXAMPLES

How (manner)



Q-How do you go to school?

A- I go to school by bus.



Q-How many kids were there in the room?

A- There were six kids in the room.



Q-How did Arman hurt his leg?

A- He fell down from the swing.



Q-How old are you?

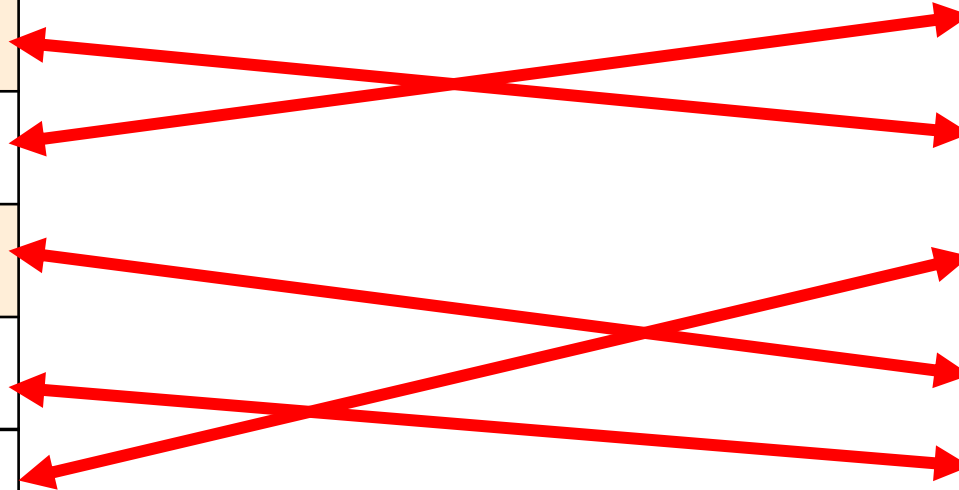
A- I am six years old.

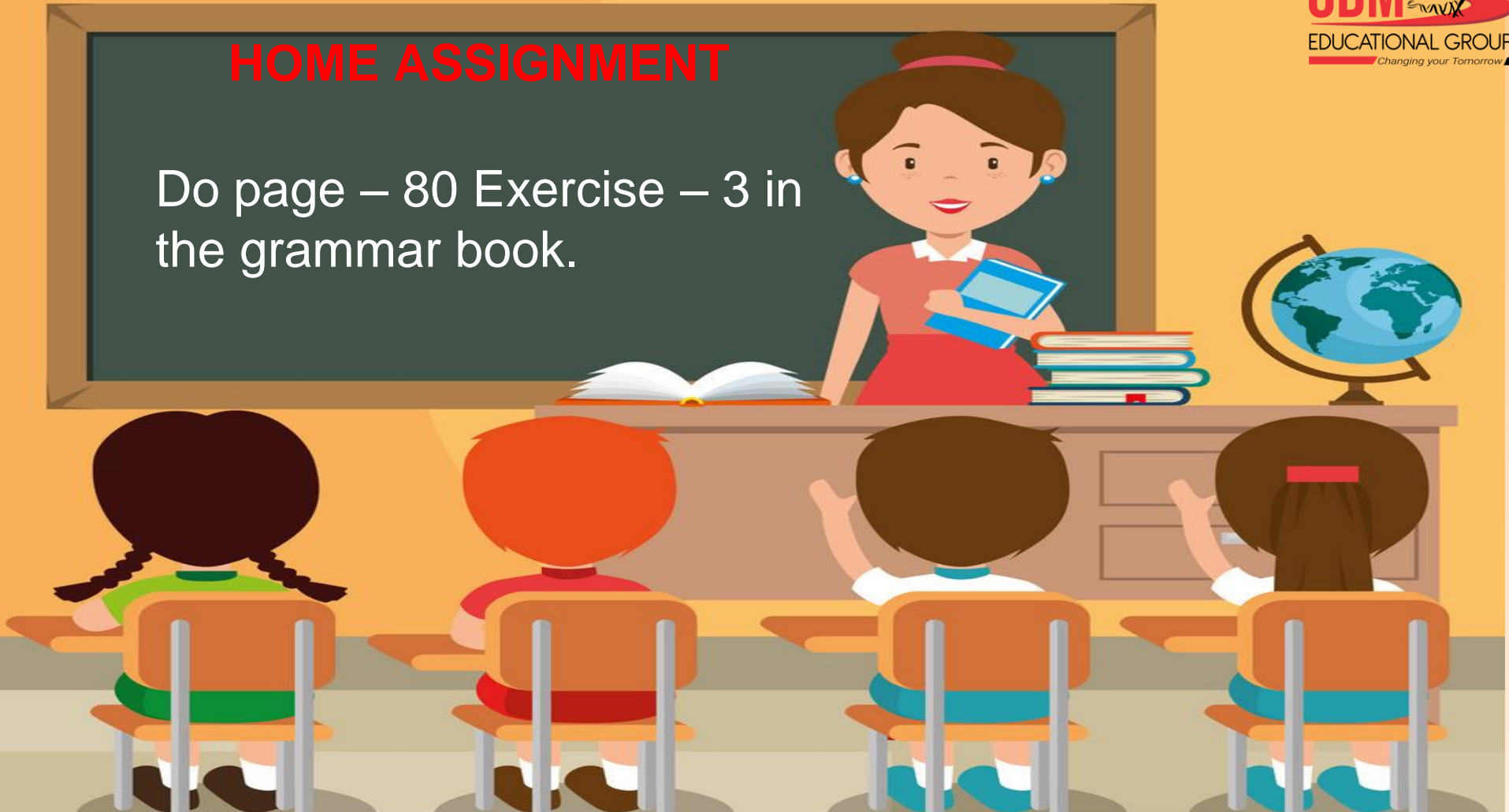
