Question Words





Question Words



The diagram illustrates seven question words, each on a balloon. A boy is shown holding a string of balloons. The balloons are arranged as follows: 'Who?' (red), 'What' (yellow), 'Which?' (blue), 'How?' (green), 'Where?' (yellow), 'When?' (blue), and 'Why?' (red).

Each question word helps us ask a different kind of question.

QUESTION ABOUT Person



EXAMPLE

Q- **Who** hid my book?

A- **Tom** hid your book.

Place



Q- **Where** are you going?

A- I am going to the **college**.

QUESTION ABOUT Time



EXAMPLE

Q- **When** does the next bus arrive?

A- The next bus will arrive at **7 o'clock**.

Q- **Why** are you upset?

A- I am upset **because I** lost my pet.

QUESTION ABOUT

Thing



Choice or something in particular

EXAMPLE

Q- **What** you had for breakfast?

A- We had **bread and butter** for breakfast .



Q- **Which** pastry would you want to have?

A- I would like to have **chocolate** .

How (manner)



- ❖ How is used in what way the action was performed.
- ❖ They are also used to ask about the condition, amount or quality of something.

EXAMPLES

How (manner)



Q-How do you go to school?

A- I go to school by bus.



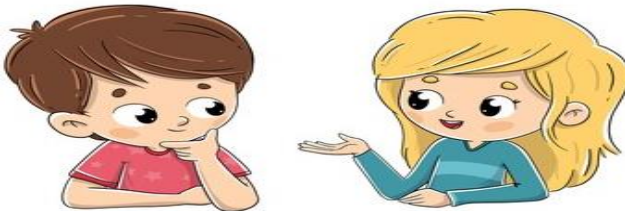
Q-How many kids were there in the room?

A- There were six kids in the room.



Q-How did Arman hurt his leg?

A- He fell down from the swing.
