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# PARTS OF A SENTENCE

# SENTENCE

*A group of words that express a complete idea, is called sentence.*



## EXAMPLE

**My name is Sara. I have a car.  
You are my friend.**

Every sentence has two *essential* parts:

**subject** and **predicate**

The *subject* of a sentence is the part about which something is being said.

The *predicate* of a sentence is the part which says something about the subject.



## Examples Subject and Predicate

- A boy is looking to hide himself during the rain.

- The laptop is placed on the table for charging.

Sub

Predicate

- He hits his car with a pole while parking.

Sub

Predicate

- Japan is known as the technology hub of the world.

Sub

Predicate

- Jonathan is feeling tired and wants to sleep.

Predicate

- The milk is very good for a healthy body.

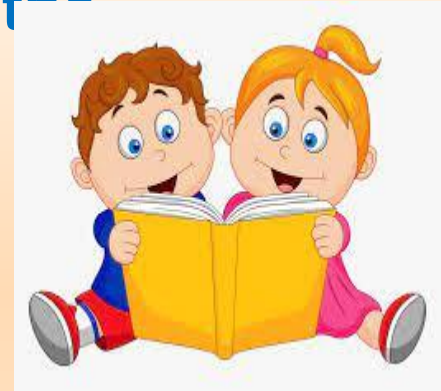
