

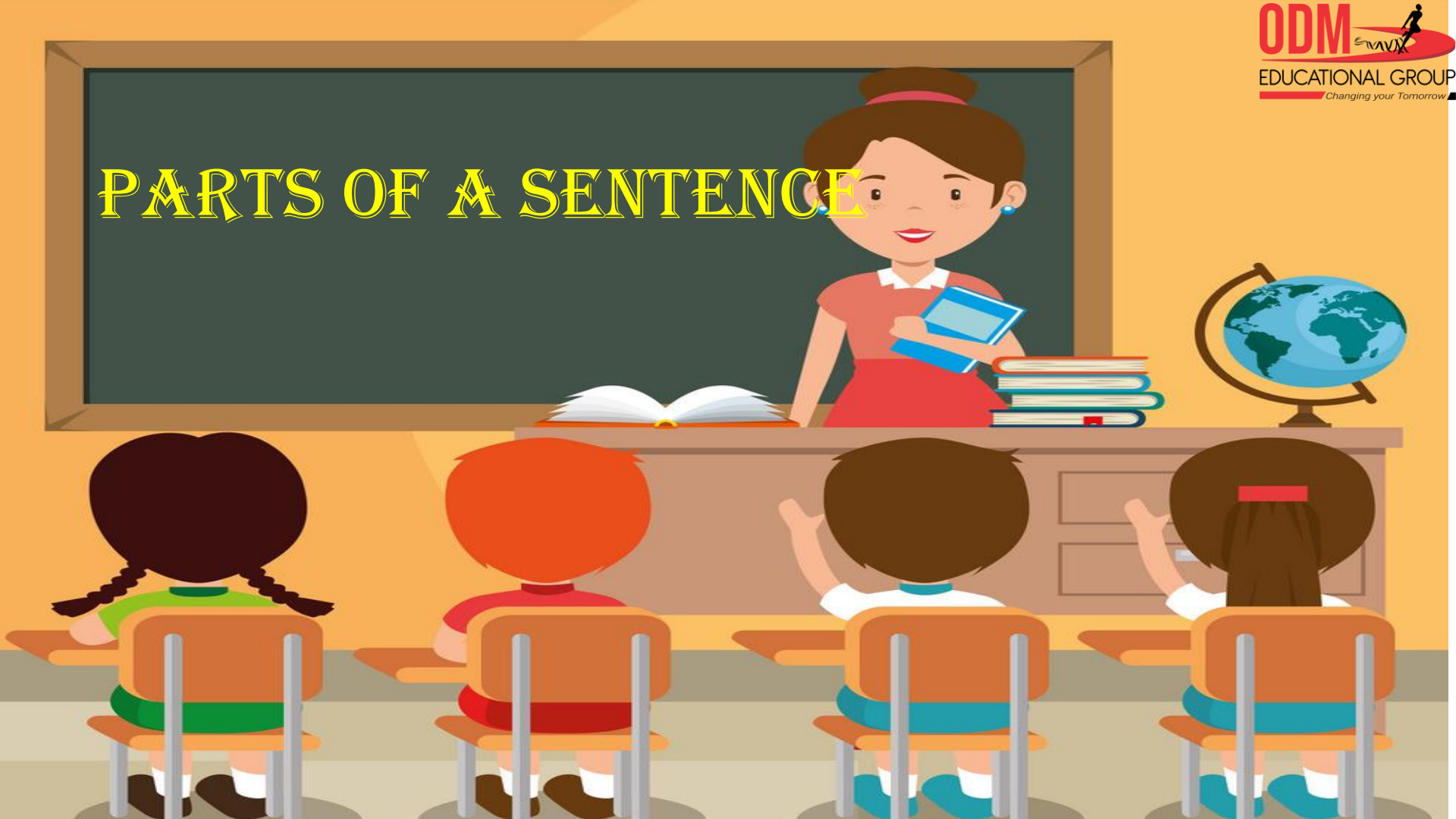

PARTS OF A SENTENCE



Read the sentences carefully and choose the correct option .

SENTENCE

A group of words that express a complete idea, is called sentence.



EXAMPLE

**My name is Sara. I have a car.
You are my friend.**

Every sentence has two *essential* parts:

subject and **predicate**

The *subject* of a sentence is the part about which something is being said.

The *predicate* of a sentence is the part which says something about the subject.



Examples Subject and Predicate

- **A boy** is looking to hide himself during the rain.

Sub

Predicate

- **The laptop** is placed on the table for charging.

Sub

Predicate

- **He** hits his car with a pole while parking.

Sub

Predicate

- **Japan** is known as the technology hub of the world.

Sub

Predicate

- **Jonathan** is feeling tired and wants to sleep.

Sub

Predicate

- **The milk** is very good for a healthy body.
