

SENTENCE

A group of words that express a complete idea, is called sentence.

The *subject* of a sentence is the part about which something is being said.

The *predicate* of a sentence is the part which says something about the subject.

Examples Subject and Predicate

- A boy is looking to hide himself during the rain. Sub Predicate
- The laptop is placed on the table for charging. Sub Predicate
- · He hits his car with a pole while parking.
- Sub Predicate
- · Japan is known as the technology hub of the world. Predicate

Predicate

- Jonathan is feeling tired and wants to sleep.
- The milk is very good for a healthy body.
