CONJUNCTIONS

A Conjunction connects words or groups of words.



The dog is a faithful **and** intelligent animal.



If you work hard, you will succeed in life.



I want to go to play, **but** I am sick.



Is it Thursday **or** Friday today?

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Changing your Tomorrow

Let us know some more conjunctions:

When: used to show the time of action

Example: It was midnight **when** I reached home.



While: used to show two or more actions happening at same time

Example: I bought some gifts **while** I was coming from my office.



Before: used to show time (means 'earlier than')

Example: You must brush your teeth **before** you go to bed.



After: used to show time (means 'later than')

Example: I will call you **after** I reach my home.



Till: used to talk about a situation that will continue upto a certain moment

Example: She ran and ran, **till** she tumbled right down a rabbit hole.
