A possessive noun indicates possession or ownership. It shows that someone or something belongs to someone or something else.

Noun + apostrophe + s =  
Possessive noun



# Rules for forming possessive nouns

To turn a plural noun that ends in – s we add an apostrophe (') after the - s

Plural Nouns	
<b>If the noun ends in "s", add '</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Boys' ball</b> </li><li>• <b>Tables' legs</b> </li><li>• <b>Girls' hands</b> </li></ul>

When a singular or plural noun that does not end in – s we add an apostrophe (') and an - s

## Singular Nouns



If it's a common noun, add "s"

- Dog's house 
- Book's words 
- Girl's dolls 
- Bird's chicks 
- Car's engine 
- Sister's room 
- Jim's pen 
- My mom's bag 

If the noun doesn't end in "s", add '

- Women's bag 
- Children's dolls 
- Men's shoes
