Possessive Nouns



A possessive noun indicates possession or ownership. It shows that someone or something belongs to someone or something else.

Noun + apostrophe + s =
Possessive noun

Rules for forming possessive nouns

Singular Nouns



If it's a
common
noun,
add "s"

- Dog's house 
- Book's words 
- Girl's dolls 
- Bird's chicks 
- Car's engine 
- Sister's room 
- Jim's pen 
- My mom's bag 

Plural Nouns

Regular Plural

If the
noun
ends in
"s", add '

- Boys' ball 
- Tables' legs 
- Girls' hands 

Irregular Plural

If the
noun doesn't
end in "s",
add '

- Women's bag 
- Children's dolls 
- Men's shoes
