SPEAKING ACTIVITY

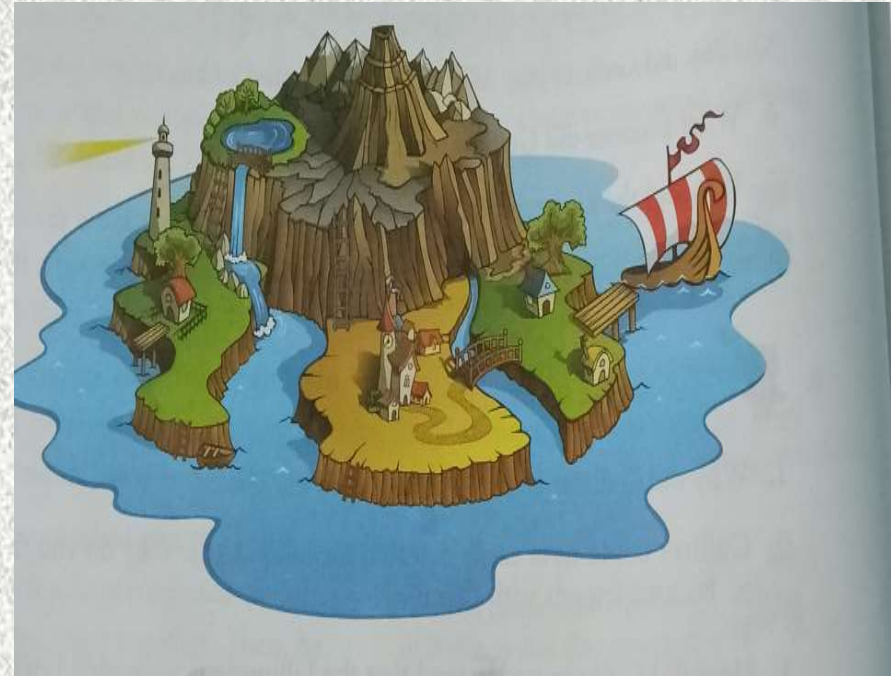


Look at the map of an island. Imagine you have gone on an adventure trip to this island with your friends. Use the map and play the game I Lost My Way



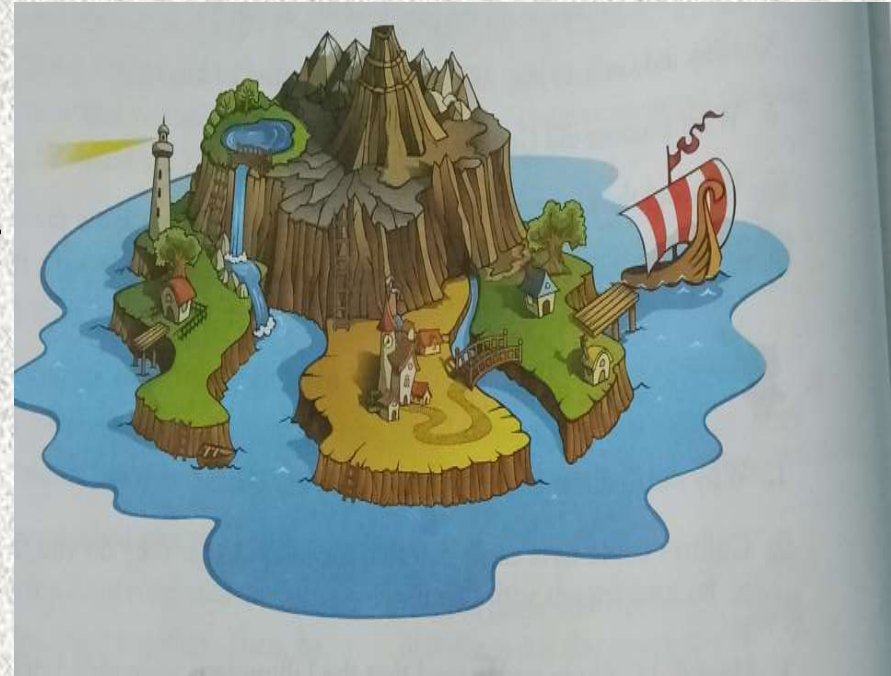
ASKING FOR DIRECTIONS
