

What is a paragraph?

- Paragraph is a group of sentences that describe or explain a topic or idea.
- Each sentence in the paragraph give information about the topic.
- The sentences must be in the right order to understand the information.



MAIN PARTS OF A PARAGRAPH



Changing your Temer	
1. Topic sentence	The topic sentence states the main idea of the paragraph. It shows what the whole paragraph is about.
2. Supporting sentence	They give more information about the topic sentence. It give facts, details or examples.
3. Concluding sentence	It is the last sentence in the paragraph. It summarizes the main points of the paragraph.
