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# Little Raindrops

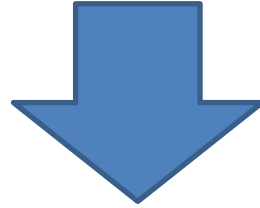
**Oh! Where do you come from,

Out of the doors at all today.**

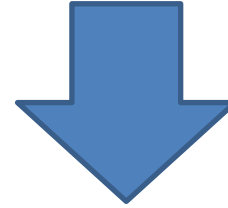
**Tell me, little raindrops,
