

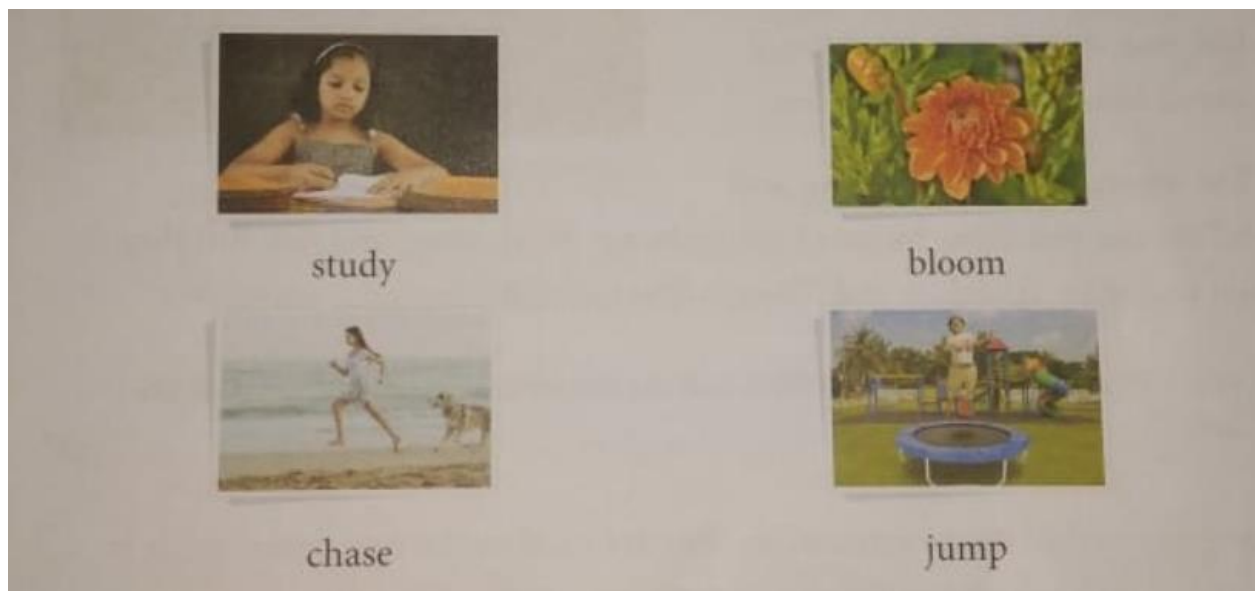
Chapter- 8

Verbs – Past tense (irregular verbs)

STUDY NOTE

Irregular verbs: Verbs that talk about the past actions but do not end with –d, –ed, –ied are called irregular verbs.
