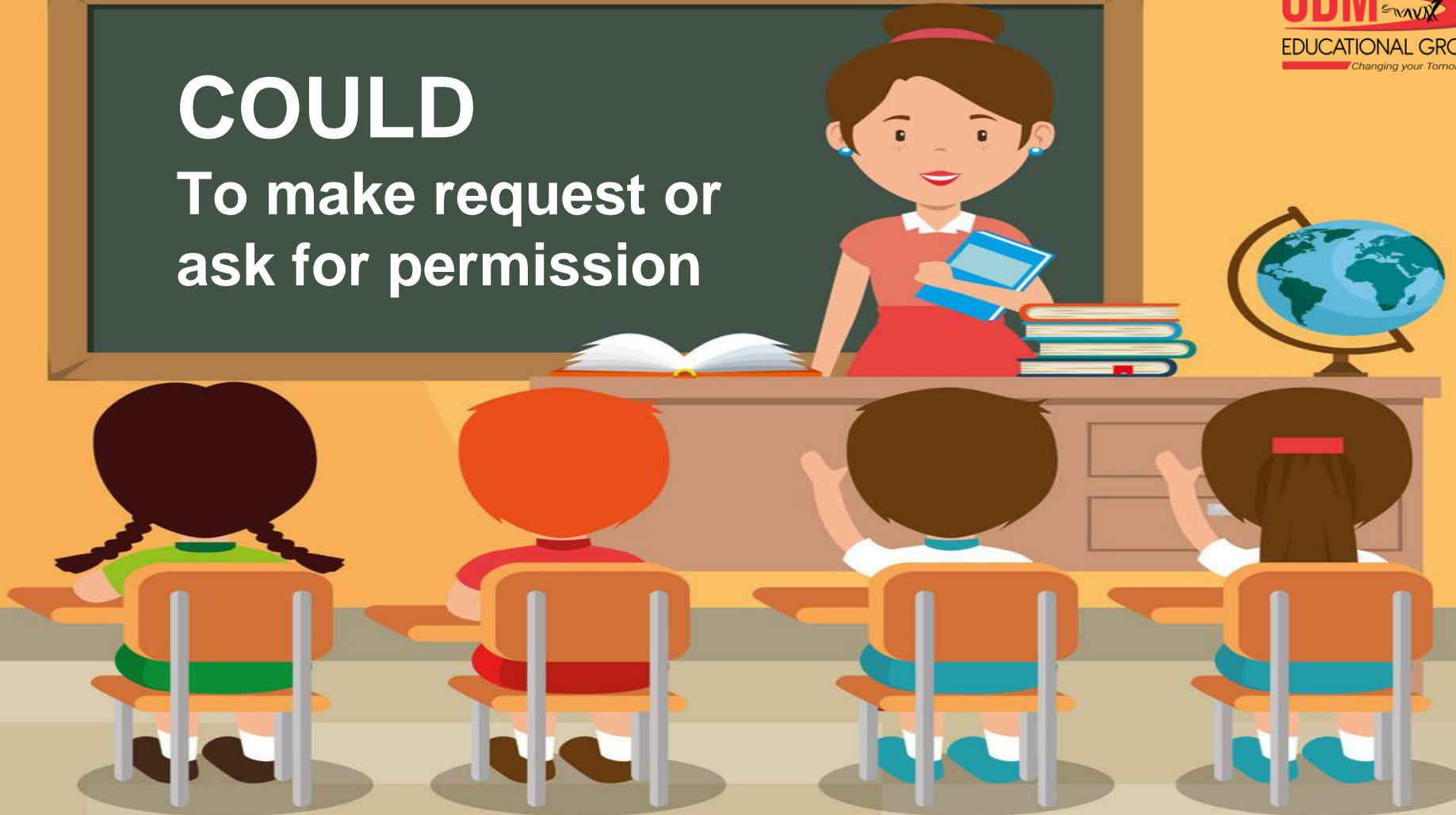

COULD

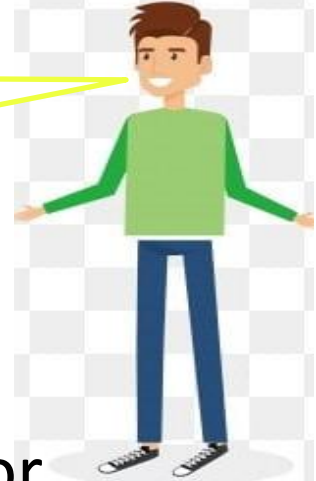
To make request or
ask for permission



Excuse me, I am looking for this address. **Could** you please help me?



Yes, I will . **Could** you show me the address?



- **Could** is used to make requests and ask for permission. **Could** is more polite than **can**.

READ THE EXAMPLES

Making Requests



Can you close the window?

Could you please close the window?

Can you help me with my homework?

Could you please help me with my homework?

Can we visit grandma this weekend?

Could we please visit grandma this weekend?

Asking for Permission



Can I borrow your book?

Could I please borrow your book?

Can I watch T.V now?

Could I please watch T.V now?

Can I make tea for you?

Could I please make tea for you?
