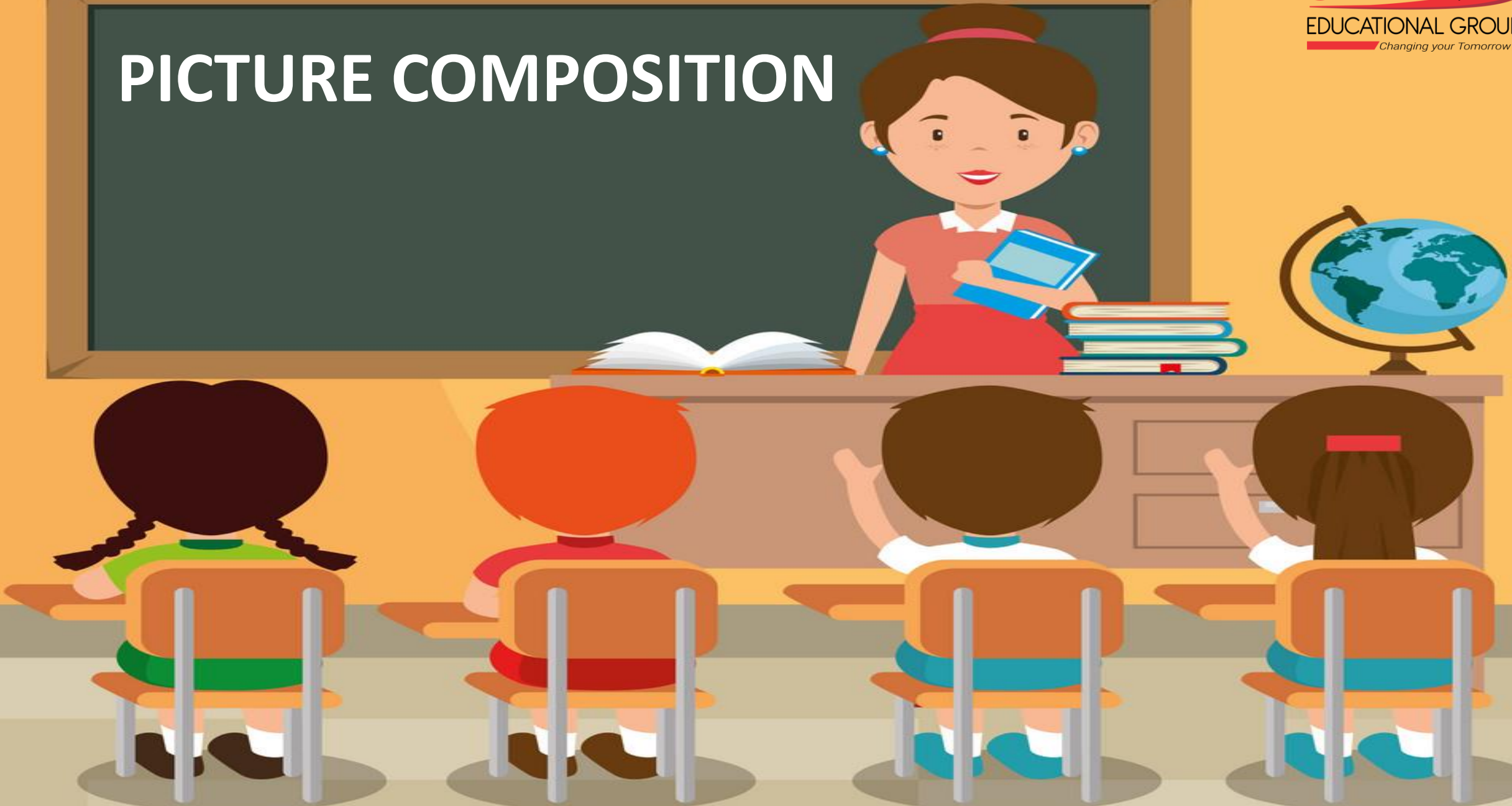

# PARTS OF A COMPOSITION

## BEGINNING

- Observe the time and place in which the story takes place.
- Note the main character of the story and introduce them.

## MIDDLE

- What the story is about?

## END

- End must be connected with the beginning and middle of the story.
