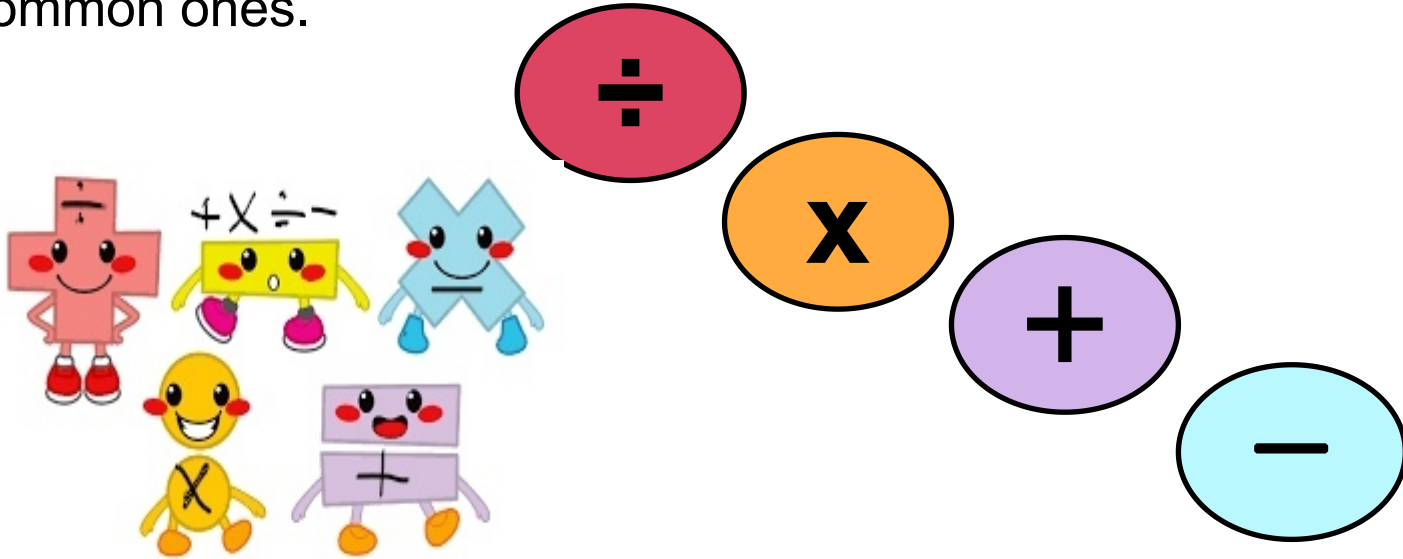

SUBTRACTION

SUMS INVOLVING BOTH ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION

There are many operations in Maths. These are some of the common ones.

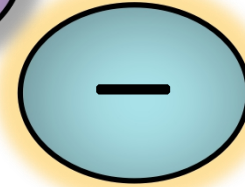
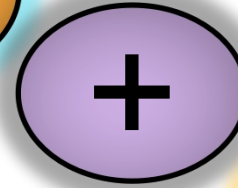
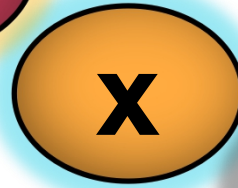
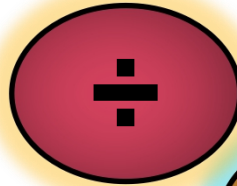


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BODMAS is a rule to deal with different operations in a question in sequence.

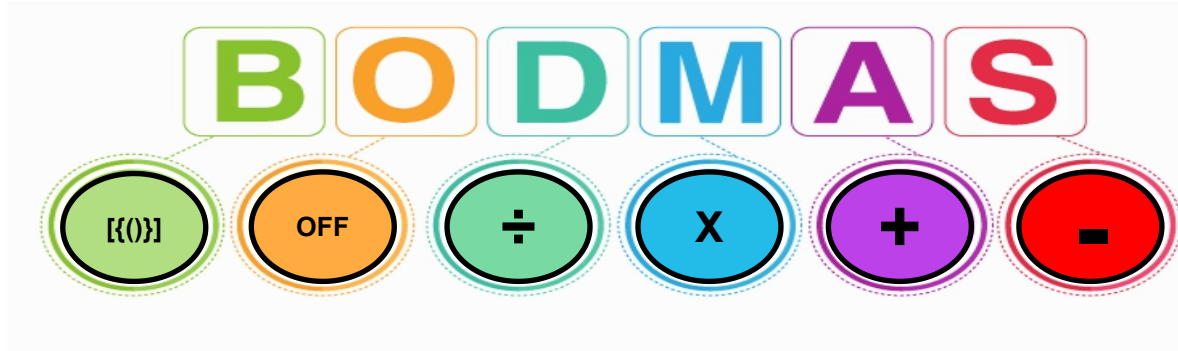


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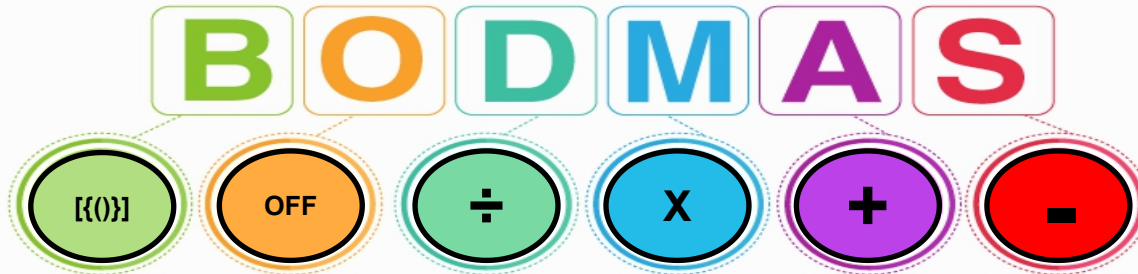
We have already learnt the operation of Addition and Subtraction.
So when we see both operation in one what should we
do?
Let us see.....



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BODMAS stands for **B**racket, **O**ff, **D**ivision, **M**ultiplication, **A**ddition, and **S**ubtraction. ... According to **BODMAS** rule, the 'brackets' have to be solved first followed by 'off ', then Division, Multiplication, Addition and at the end Subtraction.



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First work out	–	brackets	(B)
then perform	–	'of'	(O)
then	–	÷ (division)	(D)
after that	–	× (multiplication)	(M)
next	–	+ (addition)	(A)
at the end	–	– (subtraction)	(S)

So we first work out for 'brackets', then perform 'of', then 'division', after that 'multiplication', next 'addition' and at the end 'subtraction'.

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1) Solve the following:

$$\text{a) } 3704 - 7263 + 5402 = 1843$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1 \\ 3704 \\ + 5402 \\ \hline \cancel{9}^8 \cancel{1}^{10} \cancel{0}^{10} 6 \\ - 7263 \\ \hline 1843 \end{array}$$

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$$\text{b) } 1324 - 3796 + 4437 - 1251 = 714$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1 \\ 1 3 2 4 \\ + 4 4 3 7 \\ \hline \cancel{5}^4 \cancel{7}^{16} \cancel{6}^{15} \cancel{1}^{11} \\ - 3 7 9 6 \\ \hline 1 9 6 5 \\ - 1 2 5 1 \\ \hline 7 1 4 \end{array}$$

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$$\text{c) } 4373 - 2431 - 4327 + 3124 = 739$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 4373 \\ + 3124 \\ \hline 7497 \\ - 2431 \\ \hline \cancel{5}^4 \cancel{0}^{10} \cancel{6}^5 \cancel{6}^{16} \\ - 4327 \\ \hline 739 \end{array}$$

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$$\text{d) } 5142 + 1210 - 3597 = 2755$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 5142 \\ + 1210 \\ \hline \cancel{6}^5 \cancel{3}^{12} \cancel{5}^{14} \cancel{2}^{12} \\ - 3597 \\ \hline 2755 \end{array}$$

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2) Subtract 2694 from the sum of 1515 and 2123.

$$1515 + 2123 - 2694 = 944$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1515 \\ + 2123 \\ \hline 3638 \\ - 2694 \\ \hline 0944 \end{array}$$

(Note: In the original image, the digits 3, 6, and 3 in the intermediate sum 3638 are crossed out with diagonal lines, and the numbers 2, 15, and 13 are written above them to indicate borrowing.)

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3) Subtract the sum of 2315 and 1208 from the sum of 3215 and 1006.

$$(3215 + 1006) - (2315 + 1208) = 698$$
