3 5 7 4 , 8 1 5 2 , 6 5 2 0 , 4 2 9 6

ARRANGING NUMBERS

Compare the hundred place and arrange in ascending order



Th	H	T	O
3	5	7	4
8	1	5	2
6	5	2	0
4	2	9	6

We see, $3 < 4 < 6 < 8$

So, $3574 < 4296 < 6520 < 8152$

NUMBERS

ARRANGING NUMBERS

Compare the hundred place and arrange in descending order



Th	H	T	O
3	5	7	4
8	1	5	2
6	5	2	0
4	2	9	6

We see, $8 > 6 > 4 > 3$

So, $8152 > 6520 > 4296 < 3574$

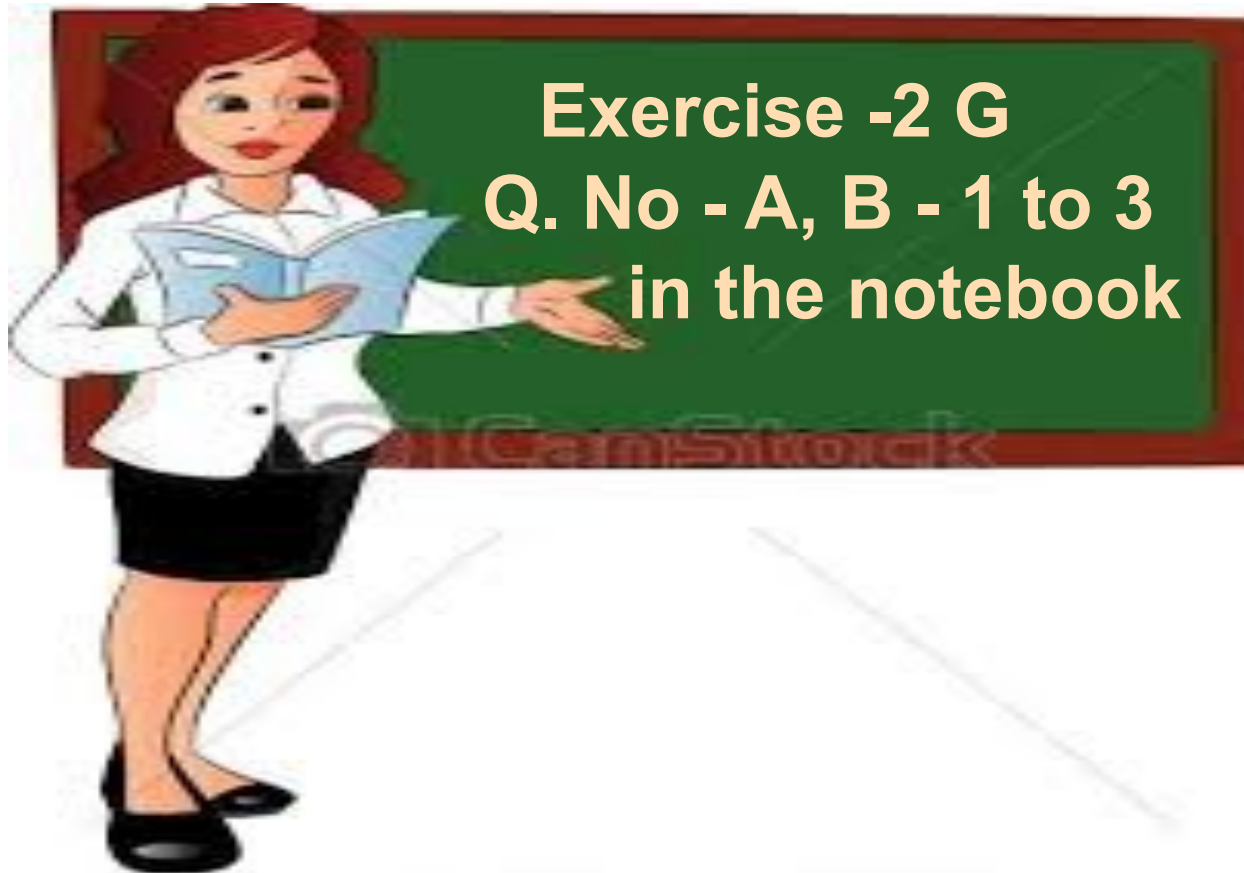

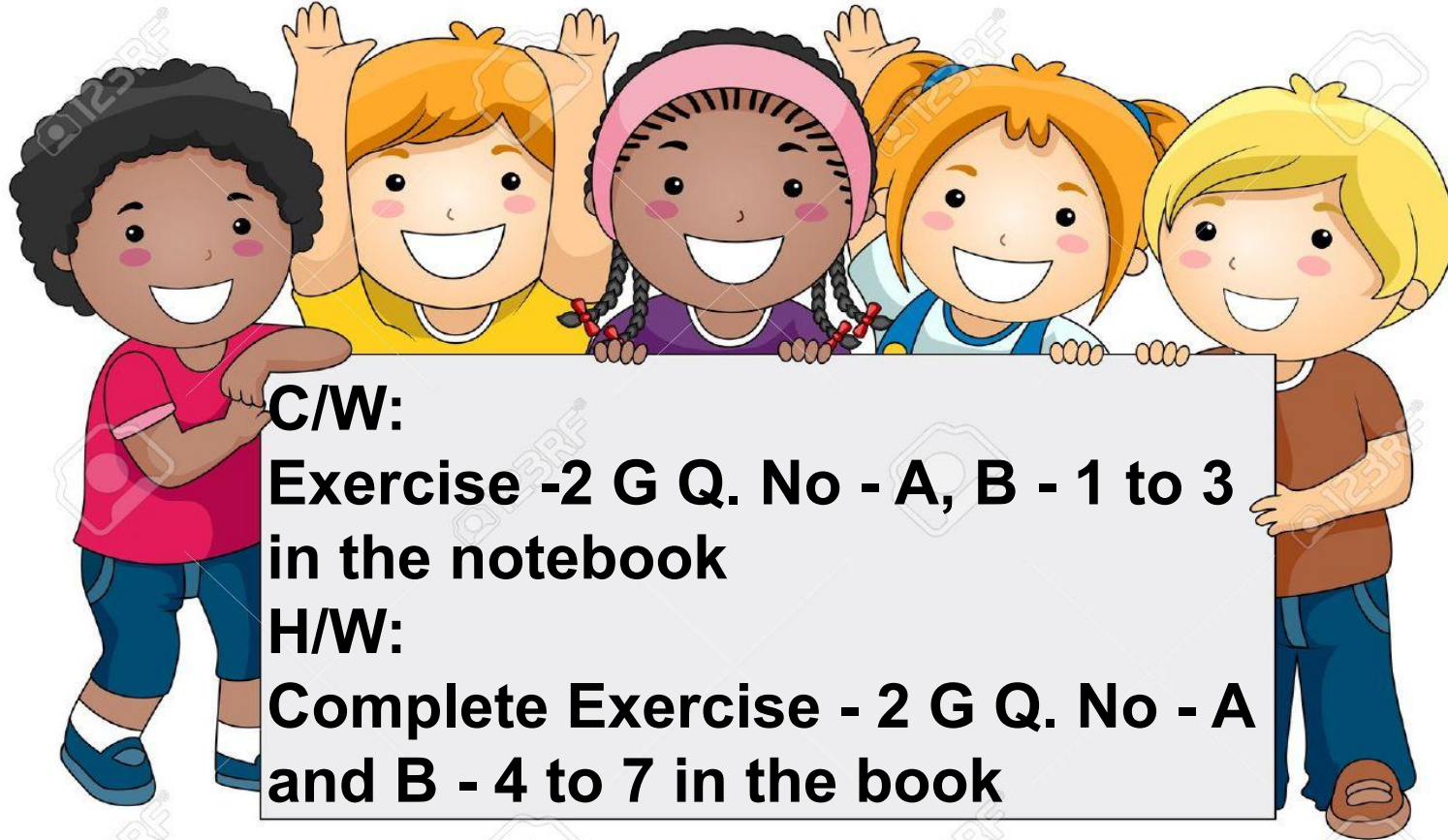
