# LIVING THINGS GROW

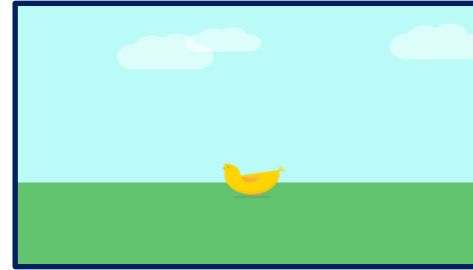
- A human baby grows into an adult.

All **living things** grow and change.

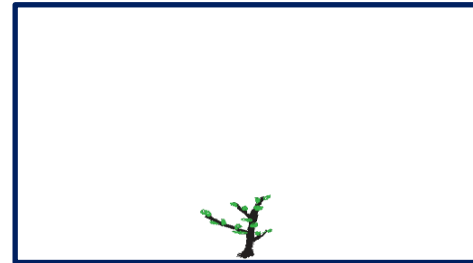
Whereas computers, dolls, rocks, air and water do not grow as they are **non-living things**.

# LIVING THINGS NEED FOOD

Human beings and animals need food to live. Food helps them to grow.

- Animals get their food from plants or other animals.
- Plants make their food with the help of air, water and sunlight.
- Non living things like doll never need food.

Only **living things need food.**

# LIVING THINGS FEEL

Animals and human beings feel.

- Cat purrs when it stroked
- Dog barks at stranger
- Human being laugh,cry,gets angry or feel pain.
- Plants grows towards light.

Only **living things** can feel.

However the toys do not cry if you throw them on the floor as they are **non living thing**.

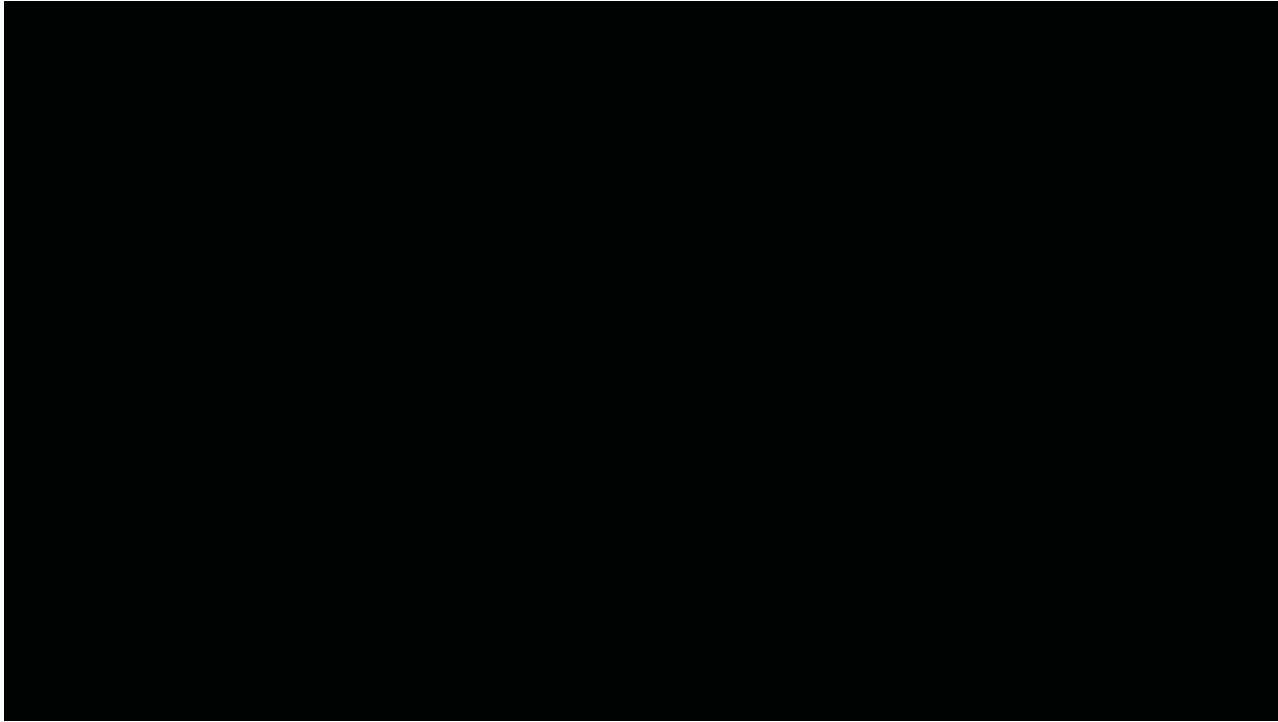
