A. DEFINE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Thermometer –

An instrument used to measure body temperature. Temperature is measured either on the Centigrade Scale or on the Fahrenheit Scale. In India we use the Centigrade Scale.

2. Nesting Habits –

Birds build their nests to lay eggs and to protect themselves from their enemies and bad weather. Birds use material like twigs, dry leaves, cotton, thread, wool, feather, hair, pieces of cloth, paper and pebbles to build their nests.

3. The Digestive System –

Digestion is the process of changing of food into a simple form so that it can be used by the body. Mouth, food pipe, stomach, small intestine, large intestine and anus make up the digestive system.

B. Give two examples of each.

1. Organs related to the circulatory system.

Ans:- The heart, The blood vessels

2. Perching birds.

Ans:- Sparrows, Mynahs

3. Units for measuring length.

Ans:- Centimetre, Metre

4. Units for measuring capacity.

Ans:- Millilitres, Litres.

1. Name the body parts that were used by people long ago to measure length.

Ans:- Three body parts that were used by people long ago to measure length are hands for handspan, forearm for cubit and foot for footspan.

2. What does oxygen do inside body?

Ans:- The oxygen burns up the food we eat and give us energy.

3. What kind of beaks do most grain-eating birds have?

Ans:- Most grain eating birds have short, hard and horny beak.
