LET'S RECAPITULATE

- Some animals eat plants are called herbivores. Some eat flesh of other animals are called carnivores and some eat both plants and the flesh of other animals are called omnivores.
- Domestic animals do a lot of work for us. They need energy-giving food.
- Some flesh-eating animals swallow their food, some tear and chew their food, some swallow and some gnaw.
- Some grass eating animals first swallow their food without chewing. Later they bring it back into their mouth and they chew it with their grinding teeth. The process is known as chewing the cud.
- Liquid food is lapped or sucked up by some animals like Dog and Cat.
- We should be kind to animals and take care of them.
