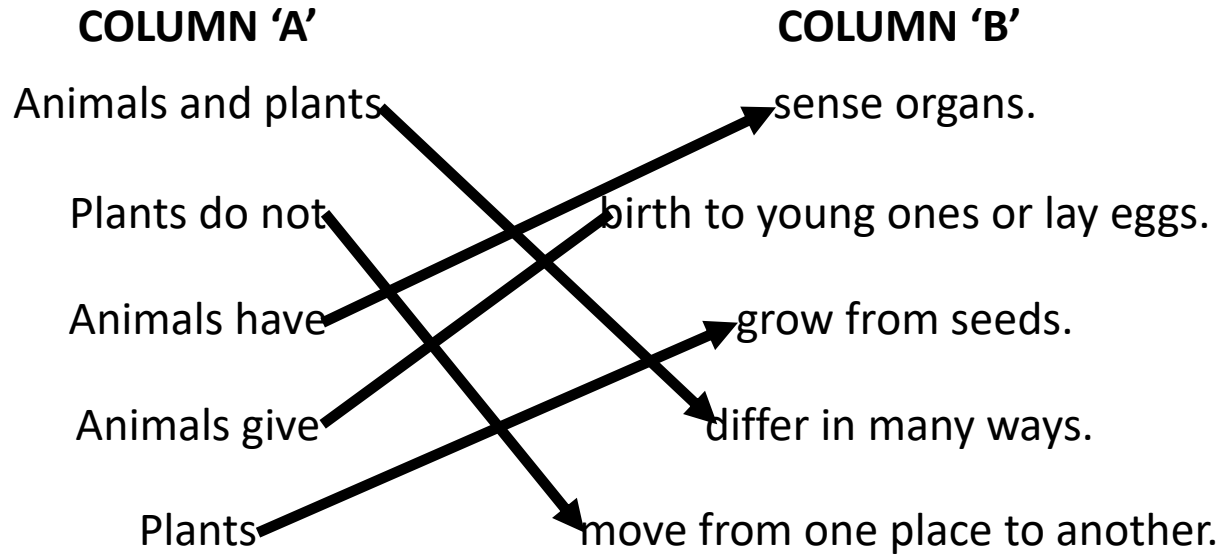

- 1. Why do animals move from place to place?

ANS: Animals moves from place to place in search of food and to protect themselves from their enemies.

- 2. From where animals get their food?

ANS: Animals get their food from plants as well as from other animals. Some animals like cows and elephants eat plants like grass and sugarcane and animals like lions and tigers eat other animals like deer and rabbit.

- 3. Mention three different ways by which the living things breathe.

ANS: Animals like cows, dogs etc. breathe through their lungs, fishes breathe through their gills, insects like butterflies and flies breathe through air holes on their bodies. Plants breathe through the tiny pores on their leaves called stomata.

ANS: Some animals like birds and snakes lay eggs. Some animals like cats and cows give birth to their young ones.
