PADDY	rice crop

NEW WORDS	MEANINGS
STEAM	water vapour
DECAYING LEAVES	a dead and rotting leaves
HUMUS	parts of dead plants and insects.
LOAM	a mixture of sand and clay
MANURE	a mixture of cow dung and decaying leaves.
