

What do the following animals or birds eat?







HERBIVORES

The animals which eat grass or green plants are called plant eating animals or herbivores.

Example : Cow and Giraffe







CARNIVORES

The animals which eat flesh are called carnivores.

Example: Lion, Tiger







OMINIVORES

Animals eat different parts of plants as well as flesh of other animals are called omnivores. Example: Crow & Bear Humans are also omnivores.















FOOD FOR DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Domestic animals do a lot of work for us.

Animals like oxen, horses, camels, mules, elephants, donkeys carry loads as well as work in the fields.

They should be fed on the energy giving food like oat and fodder.









Animals like cow, goat and buffaloes give us milk.

They need milk producing food.

They should be fed on grass and oilseed-cakes.
