- Tissues join together to make an organ.
- Many organs together form an organ system.

1. How do we see the wonderful things in the world?

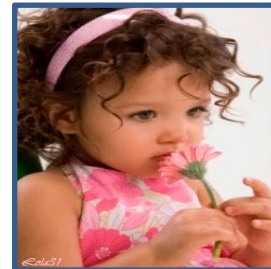
Ans: We see the wonderful things in the world through our eyes.

Ans: We know a fruit is sweet or sour through our tongue.



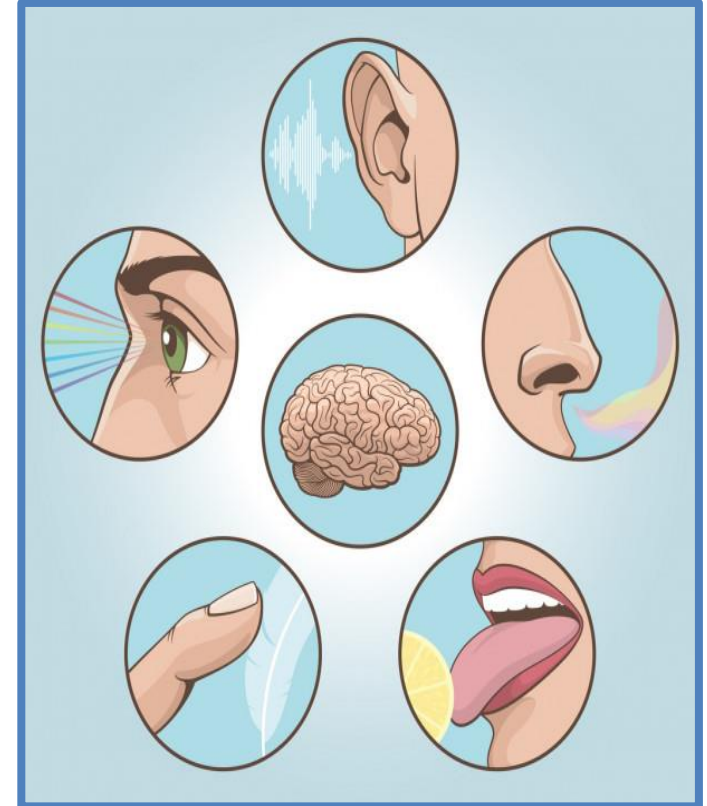
5. How do we feel something is smooth or rough

OUR SENSE ORGANS

- We have five sense organs - the eyes , the ears, the nose, the tongue and the skin.
- All these sense organs are connected to the brain through the nerves.
- The sense organs send messages to the brain. The brain makes us understand pictures, sounds, smells, tastes and feelings.
