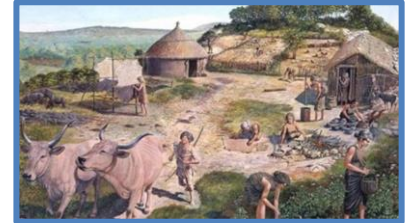

TAMING OF ANIMALS

Early human beings learned that some animals such as horses, donkeys, cows, bullocks, or dogs could be tamed more easily than others.



They used these animals for ploughing their farmlands.



They also got food such as milk and meat from these animals



HOW TRANSPORT DEVELOPED

Early humans had to walk long distance carrying the animals that they killed also wood for making Fire and for constructing houses.



The animals that they had tamed were used for carrying loads. This made the work of transporting loads little easier.



HOW TRANSPORT DEVELOPED

They discovered wood floating in the river then a number of straight logs were tied together to make rafts which helped early human to travel and also carry heavy loads by the river..



For travelling and transporting heavy loads by land, they made carts that could be pulled along the ground which were called sledges. The people pushed and pulled the sledges themselves or with the help of animals. But the sledges could move only on smooth grounds.
