
GLOBE



- Globe is a man made three dimensional model of Earth.
- Globe shows the exact position of continent, country, ocean seas
- We can rotate to see the different places.
- However globe is not big enough to show all the places detail.


- Maps are two dimensional representation of globe.
- A map is a representation or a drawing of the earth's surface, or a part of it, on a flat surface.
- It could be hand drawn or printed.
- It helps us identify the places and locations wit hin an area helping us to navigate from one place to another.


ATLAS



- · An atlas is a book of maps.
- An atlas has a table of contents, an index, and a map key, which help you find information in an atlas.
- Atlases are also available in multimedia format.


Direction on Map

- There are four main directions.
- They are East, West, North and South.
- If we stand facing a map the top part W
 of the map is north, bottom is south,
 the right is east and the left is west.
- These directions helps us to locate places on a map.





Find the Directions






Compass

- The needle of a compass always points to the north.




