It protects us from enemies.**

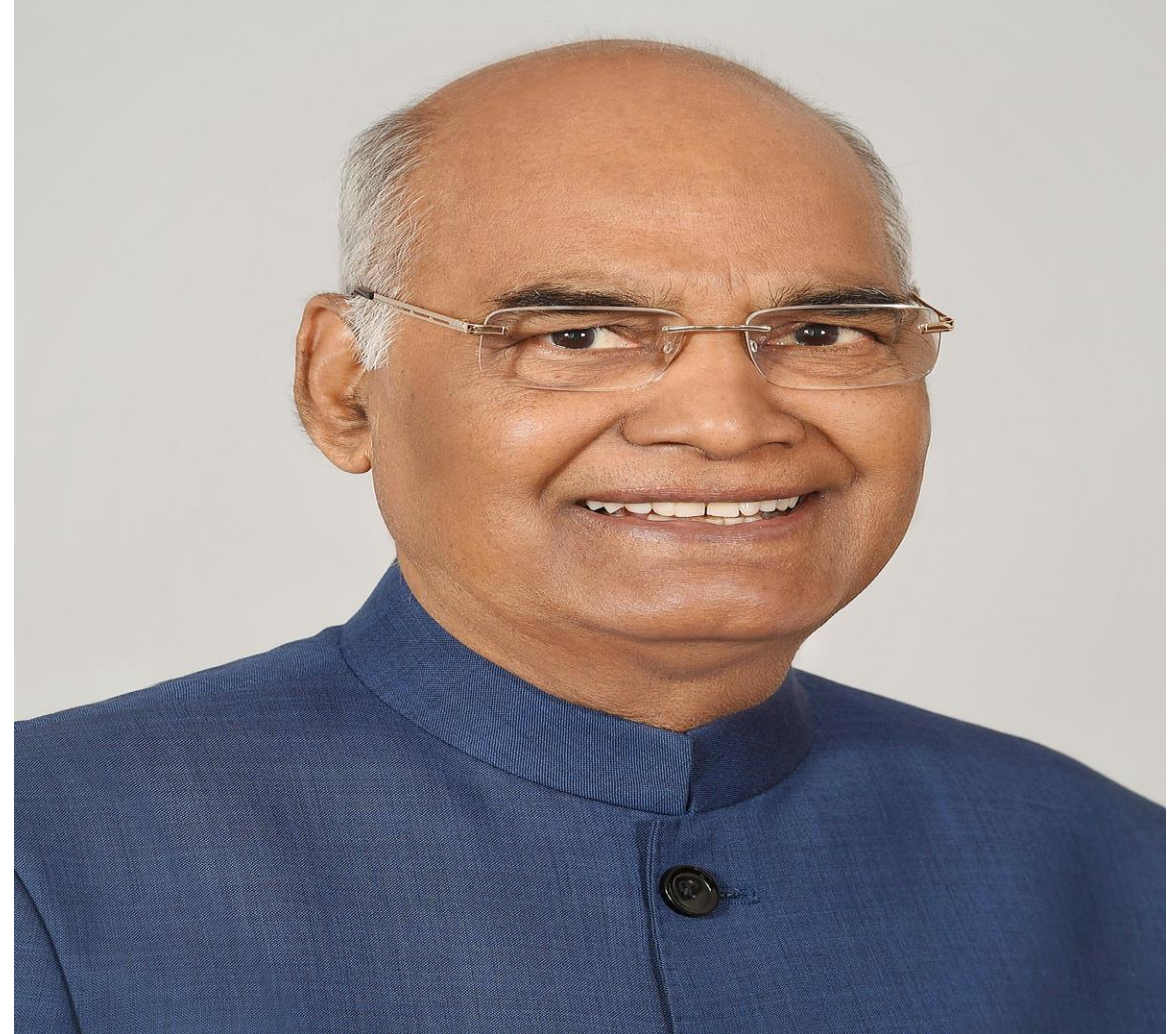


What is Government
