Why do we wear clothes?


To protect our body from rough weather

What Our Men Wear

- Men wear different clothes indifferent states.
- Kurtas worn with dhotis, pyjamas, churidars or lung is are popular in most of the northern and eastern states, as well as in the states of Central India.









A lungi is a cloth tied around the waist by men.
 Lungi-kurta or lungi with a shirt is commonly worn in the southern





The lungi is called mundu in Kerala and veshti in Tamil Nadu.



In Rajasthan, a pyjama or dhoti is worn as the lower garment and angrakha as upper garment.







In Gujarat, men wear a short frilled white angrakha over white pyjamas or dhoti and jacket.

PAGRI AND TOPI

- Indian men often cover their heads with turbans or pagris, and traditional caps or topis.
- The way these are worn varies from region to region.

Word meanings

- lungi/dhoti/mundu: a cloth worn around the waist by men
- angrakha: short jacket like shirt worn over dhoti by men of Gujarat and Rajasthan
- turban: a head dress for men made by winding a length of cloth tightly around the head
- ghaghra/lehenga/pavada: long skirts worn by women
- kanchli/kurta/choli/kameez: blouse or shirt worn by women
- salwar/pyjama/churidar: trouser-like garment worn by women
- odhni/dupatta: cloth draped over the chest or head by women
