

Tourist Attractions



- A large number of tourists visit every year.
- An important landmark is the Gateway of India.
- Close to it are statues of Shivaji and swami Vivekananda.
- There are many beaches in Mumbai like Chowpatty, Versova Marve and Juhu.
- Ten kilometers from Mumbai are the Elephant Caves.
- There are four rock-cut temples in these caves.

Transport



- The city has one of the best public transport systems in India.
 Most of the people commute by bus and local trains (also called suburban trains).
- The Chhatrapati Shivaji
 International Airport is the busiest airport in the country.





The Bandra-Worli Sea Link

- The Bandra–Worli Sea Link is a 5.6 km long, 8-lane wide bridge that links Bandra in the Western Suburbs of Mumbai with Worli in South Mumbai.
- This is also known as Rajiv Gandhi sea link.





Industries and Institutions

- Mumbai has many factories. These factories make textile, medicines, oils, chemicals and electronic goods.
- In Bombay High, off the Mumbai coast, lies one of India's most important oilfields, here, crude oil extracted from the seabed.
- Petrol and diesel are produced from this crude oil.
- Important institutions in Mumbai are the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC),
- Tata Institute Fundamental Research (TIFR)
- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT).
